

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the **3rd Sunday of Lent**. In the gospel we hear the story of Jesus' cleansing of the Temple. He drove out the money changers because they had been making "my Father's house a marketplace". Sin has the same negative effect on us. We are all temples of the Holy Spirit, made in God's image and likeness. Yet sin has a way of polluting the house (us) in which our Father dwells. This Lent is an opportunity to do some house cleaning. What are the areas of my "temple" (life) that need cleansing?

This weekend **Quincy Notre Dame** kicks off their **Annual Fund with a talk at all Masses by current QND students**. As a QND alumnus, I can personally attest to the value of a QND education. I ask that parish members listen with your hearts this week to the testimony provided by our QND students. We hope that we all might respond generously to the QND Annual Fund Drive.

The season of **Lent** should include the following elements for us to focus upon: (1) Fasting -giving up something we like; (2) Prayer; and (3) Charity – doing charitable works for others and donating money to charity. Blessed Sacrament will provide several liturgical and devotional opportunities each week during Lent to assist you in your spiritual growth during this Lenten season.

This weekend our RCIA elect begin the **Scrutinies**. The Church teaches that the scrutinies are "rites for self-searching and repentance... The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect." We pray that our elect and candidates may join us throughout Lent to reflect on their own weaknesses and find healing in God's grace and mercy.

Please join us throughout the Season of Lent for our **Wednesday Lenten Soup Suppers at 6:00 p.m.** in the Gathering Space. This event is sponsored weekly by our Men's Group. Please come join us!

This upcoming Tuesday evening, March 5, our Pastoral Council is organizing a **Family Bowling Night at Casino Lanes from 5:30-8:30 p.m.** Cost is \$10 per person. Come join us for a fun night of bowling with other parish families of Blessed Sacrament.

Next weekend we will celebrate a **40 Hours Devotion on the weekend of March 8-10**. This devotion consists in 40 straight hours of Eucharistic Adoration, marking the 40 hours that Jesus spent in the tomb. For these 40 hours we are asking for parish members to sign up for one hour of Eucharistic Adoration from Friday 4:00 p.m. through Sunday 8:00 a.m. We will have several ways for parish members to sign up: online (Sign-up Genius) or on paper. Please consider offering one hour during this time as part of your upcoming Lenten offering.

Finally, a reminder that our **Parish Dinner is set for next Saturday, March 9** at Quincy University. This event is being organized by the Pastoral Council. Cost is \$15 per person, adults only. Cocktails are at 5:30 p.m., and Dinner is at 6:00 p.m.
