#### From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter. Jesus uses the analogy of the vine and branches to describe our unique relationship with him. "He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it produces more fruit." Pruning is an interesting phenomenon in nature. In order to bring growth a gardener has to cut back the bush or vine. Christ does the same thing with us. Sometimes it is necessary for Christ to "cut us back" in order that we produce more fruit.

Today (Sunday, April 28) at the 10:00 a.m. Mass we will honor our students who just yesterday received the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion at the Springfield Cathedral. We are very happy today to have the opportunity as a parish to celebrate our newly initiated! At our Mass this morning each of our 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade students will also receive the Carmelite scapular.



The Mega Raffle is Back!


