FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Summer has begun! We had our last day of the school year this past Wednesday, and our 8th graders at Resurrection Catholic School graduated the previous Thursday. We had the great joy of celebrating the ordination of a new priest, Fr. Aaron Waldeck, on Saturday. Truly an exciting time for us in our parish and in the Archdiocese.

As we enter summer, we often see a drop in Mass attendance. Many people will be traveling and vacationing for the summer. Many will sadly just not attend Mass, treating it as something that is part of the school year. I want to encourage everyone to strive to maintain Mass attendance, and engagement in parish life. Things quiet down in the summer, but there are still activities, most especially liturgies and devotions that occur. One such activity is the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage. As part of the National Eucharistic Revival, there are four pilgrimages beginning in the North, South, East, and West on our nation, all destined for Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress in July. The pilgrimage coming from the West began in San Francisco and will be passing through the Archdiocese in late June. The Pilgrimage will be making a stop at our Cathedral on June 28 & 29! We will have a procession from Donnelly College to the Cathedral in the afternoon of June 28. It will be a powerful witness to our larger community of our belief in the Lord's real presence in the Eucharist, and a way we can engage with Catholics from across the country in this powerful moment of Eucharistic Revival. There is a lot of work being done to prepare for the Pilgrimage. Whether you volunteer or not, please mark your calendars and join us for this historic event!

¡El verano ha comenzado! Tuvimos nuestro último día del año escolar el miércoles pasado y nuestros alumnos de octavo grado en la Escuela Católica Resurrección se graduaron el jueves anterior. Tuvimos la gran alegría de celebrar la ordenación de un nuevo sacerdote, el Padre Aaron Waldeck, el sábado. Verdaderamente un momento emocionante para nosotros en nuestra parroquia y en la Arquidiócesis.

A medida que entramos en el verano, a menudo vemos una disminución en la asistencia a Misa. Mucha gente viajará y vacacionará durante el verano. La peregrinación procedente de Occidente comenzó en San Francisco y pasará por la Arquidiócesis a finales de junio. ¡La Peregrinación hará una parada en nuestra Catedral los días 28 y 29 de junio! Tendremos una procesión desde Donnelly College hasta la Catedral en la tarde del 28 de junio. Será un testimonio poderoso para nuestra comunidad en general de nuestra creencia en la presencia real del Señor en la Eucaristía, y una forma en que podemos involucrarnos con los católicos de todo el país en este poderoso momento de Avivamiento Eucarístico. Se está trabajando mucho para preparar la Peregrinación. Currently there are only approximately 2,700 licensed foster families in Kansas. The Church is the solution! On Friday, June 28 we will gather at Donnelly College (608 N 18th St. KCK), at 3 p.m. we will start our procession to the Cathedral. We will process south on 18th street to Central Avenue. We will go east on Central to 14th street and then north on 14th street to Cathedral.

Once arriving at the parish we will have an evening of testimony, Eucharistic Amazement and Adoration followed by a dinner provided by our Knights of Columbus. On Saturday June 29 we will have Mass at 8:00 a.m. with Archbishop Naumann. Immediately following Mass we will pray the Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet. We kindly ask for parishioners and non parishioners to pre-register, that way we can plan properly.
