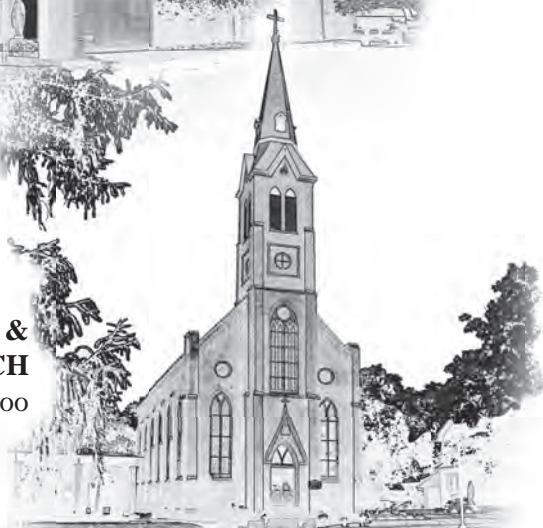

Luke Spannagel and Fr. Thomas Szydluk, provides an exciting, hopeful future for our diocese. Five young children receiving their First Communion; May Crowning; Mother's Day Blessing: all, on the Solemnity of Our Lord's Ascension into heaven! It promises to be a beautiful evening. Don't let the language challenge intimidate you! Consider being a part of the beautiful day, like all of our First Communion days, year after year!

**About This Year's Confirmation.** The history has been interesting, to say the least. We presented the diocese with a few dates in April for Confirmation, so as to avoid the many events taking place in the month of May. The last two Confirmations, the Bishop was accommodating, both in Nauvoo, and in Carthage. This year, other churches made headway into his schedule before we did, and we were offered May the 4. In my position, you don't turn down the Bishop after your own suggestions have been refused. He's the Bishop! So, May 4 it was! Our apologies, once again, to families experiencing conflicts because of graduations, proms, and sports and dance events. I was given delegation to officiate at the Confirmation, after checking with families to see what they would prefer. We'll try again in the coming years.
