FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

At this time of the year, we are in high gear with sacraments and graduations. I cannot believe how quickly this school year has gone!

This is also a time of transitions. Many will have heard that the principal of Resurrection Catholic School, Mr. Kevin O'Brien, will be moving to Bishop Ward High School next school year to serve as their principal. I am so grateful to Kevin for his three years of service to RCS, and I wish him well in his new role! The pastors and the board of trustees of RCS are in the process of hiring a new principal. Please pray that the right candidate comes forward, and for us as we discern the candidates to lead our school next year.

We are also going to be losing our DRE and Community Life Coordinator, Valentin Lobatos. Val has served our parish with such dedication for the last three years, and he has been a lifelong member of the parish. Val will be entering religious life, with the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits) this summer. I am sad to lose Val, but I am so happy for him, and tremendously proud of him for discerning God's call to him. Please pray for him as he makes this transition to the Jesuits, and I also ask that we all encourage him and express our support to him when we see him.

I am happy to share too, that we have already found a new DRE. Her name is Clarissa Fierro. Clarissa currently works at St. Paul Catholic Church in Olathe. She has roots in KCK, being an alumna of Bishop Ward and having many family members in our community. She has a degree in theology from Benedictine College, and she is tremendously faith-filled. She is also 100% bilingual. I am delighted to welcome Clarissa to the Cathedral, and I am excited for how the Lord will work through her to build up our parish family.

Right now in Kansas there are roughly 7,000 children in care, coming from all backgrounds and from every community. Many have experienced trauma and are frightened and lonely.

Archbishop Naumann says, “To be truly pro-life, we must make sure that every child has an environment where he or she can thrive.” Foster parents open their hearts and homes helping children heal, trust, and hope again. Currently there are only approximately 2,700 licensed foster families in Kansas. The Church is the solution! Everyone can help – either by becoming a foster family, supporting the families who do foster, donating necessities or gifts for children, or mentoring teens who are aging out of the system.

PRAYER ON ANNIVERSARY OF KS SUPREME COURT DECISION

April 26 is the anniversary of the Hodes & Nauser MDs vs. Schmidt Kansas Supreme Court decision. Please share the following with your parishioners to create awareness and also consider providing a communal prayer opportunity with the suggestions below. The Kansas Constitution begins by giving thanks to "Almighty God for our civil and religious privileges." It then says: "All men are possessed of equal and inalienable natural rights, among which are "life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness."

On April 26, 2019, the Kansas Supreme Court held in Hodes & Nauser MDs v. Schmidt that these words protect a supposed "natural right" to abortion. Join Archbishop Naumann in praying for an end to the supposed "natural right" to abortion in our state and a conversion of hearts so that Life might once again be protected as was intended by our forefathers. In reparation for the harms against the unborn, expectant women and families, we encourage parishes to offer an opportunity for prayer. Communal prayer could be in the form of:

- . A holy hour with adoration
- . The recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet either in the church or adoration chapel, or if that is not possible, to be done individually, preferable at the mercy hour of 3:00 p.m.
- . A Rosary

ORACION EN ANIVERSARIO DE LA DECISION DE LA CORTE SUPREMA

El 26 de abril es el aniversario de la decisión de la Corte Suprema de Kansas sobre Hodes & Nauser MDs vs. Schmidt. Comparta lo siguiente con sus feligreses para crear conciencia y también considere brindar una oportunidad de oración comunitaria con las sugerencias a continuación. La Constitución de Kansas comienza dando gracias a "Dios Todopoderoso por nuestros privilegios civiles y religiosos". Luego dice: "Todos los hombres poseen derechos naturales iguales e inalienables, entre los cuales se encuentran "la vida, la libertad y la búsqueda de la felicidad".

El 26 de abril de 2019, la Corte Suprema de Kansas sostuvo en Hodes & Nauser MDs v. Schmidt que estas palabras protegen un supuesto "derecho natural" al aborto. Únase al Arzobispo Naumann en oración por el fin del supuesto "derecho natural" al aborto en nuestro estado y una conversión de los corazones para que la vida pueda ser nuevamente protegida como lo pretendían nuestros antepasados. En reparación por los daños sufridos por los no nacidos, las mujeres embarazadas y las familias, animamos a las parroquias a ofrecer una oportunidad de oración. La oración comunitaria podría realizarse en forma de:

- Una hora santa con adoración
- El rezo de la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia ya sea en la iglesia o capilla de adoración, o si no es posible, se hará de forma individual, preferentemente a la hora de la misericordia de las 3:00 p.m.
- Un Rosario
