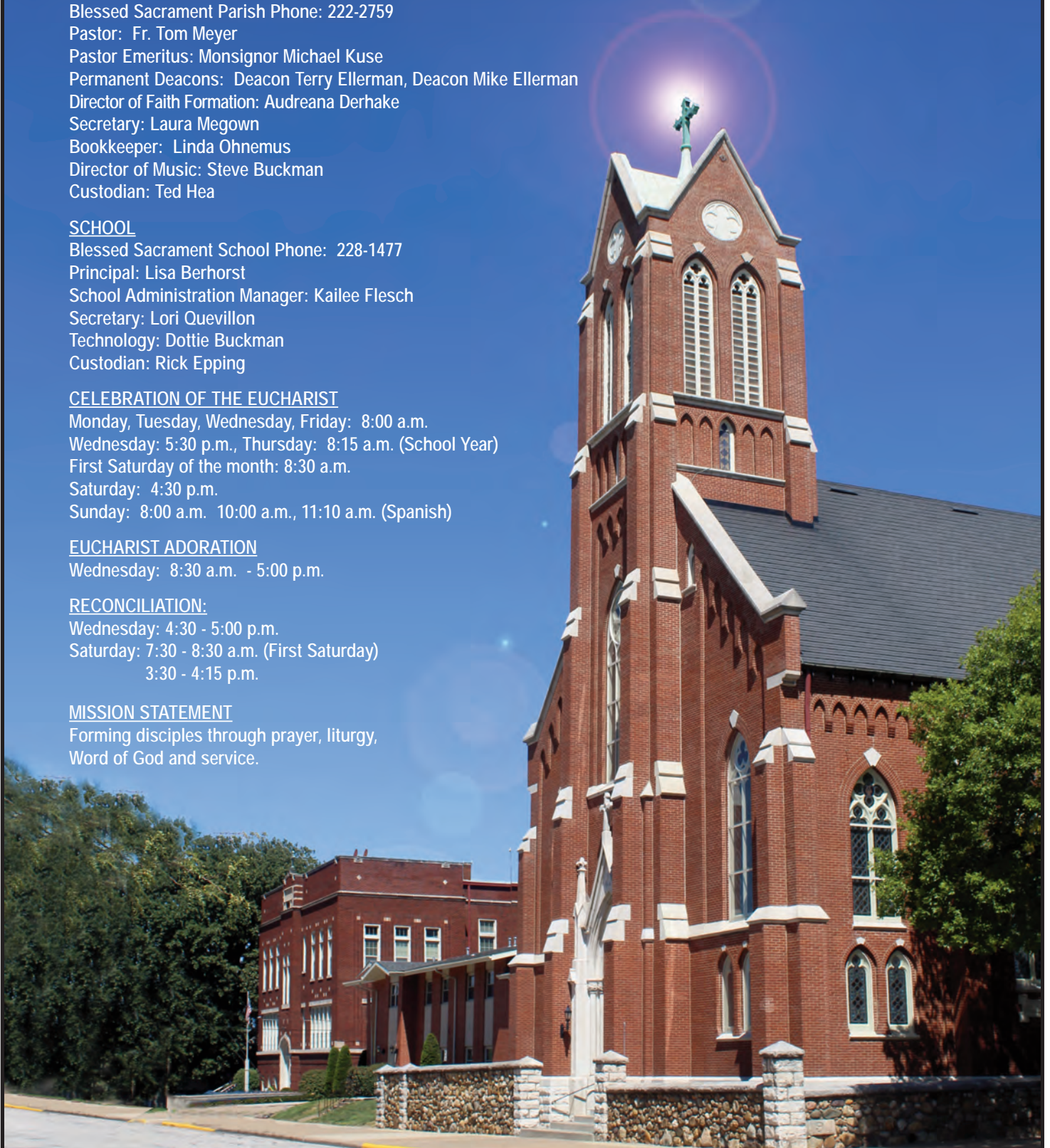

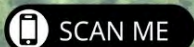

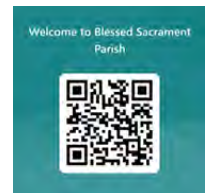

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Migrants and refugees from southwestern and southern Asian countries – such as Syria, Afghanistan, Pakistan, and Bangladesh – travel to Europe by the Balkan route, which runs through southeastern Europe. Since 2018, migrants traveling this way have ended their journeys in refugee camps. Late in 2020, a fire in one camp in Lipa, Bosnia-Herzegovina, forced 1,500 of these refugees to live outdoors during the cold and snow of winter. Pope Francis responded with a donation to build structures to accommodate the refugee families and unaccompanied minors.
