On Friday, June 28 we will gather at Donnelly College (608 N 18th St. KCK), at 3 p.m. we will start our procession to the Cathedral. We will process south on 18th street to Central Avenue. We will go east on Central to 14th street and then north on 14th street to Cathedral.

Once arriving at the parish we will have an evening of testimony, Eucharistic Amazement and Adoration followed by a dinner provided by our Knights of Columbus. On Saturday June 29 we will have Mass at 8:00 a.m. with Archbishop Naumann. Immediately following Mass we will pray the Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet.
