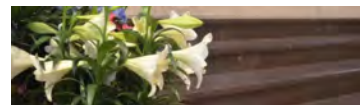

The Bible Timeline: The Story of Salvation

In this revolutionary approach to Bible study, presenter Dr. Jeff Cavins divides the Bible into twelve color-coded time periods that make it easier to follow its narrative thread. Throughout the sessions, we will learn the major people, places, and events of the Bible and discover how they reveal the remarkable story of our faith. SANCTUARY CANDLE DEDICATION CHRIST IS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Candles are used in worship as a reminder of Christ our light and the light in us that is His grace. They are also a symbol of His sacrifice. As the candle burns, it sacrifices itself in order to give light. When we light a candle, we make an offering for a particular intention. The candles that burn before the Blessed Sacrament in red globes are offerings to God for particular intentions. We have 2 week candles that cost \$20 and 1 week that cost \$10. Candle offering envelopes can be found in the votive candle stands.
