#### From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. This week we begin a 5-week Gospel short course on the Eucharist from John's Chapter 6. The gospel for the next five weeks will be a succession of passages from the Apostle John on the theology of the Eucharist. This first week we hear the miracle story of the Multiplication of the Loaves. Jesus feeds the five thousand with only five loaves and two fish. The crowds were filled with food in abundance. Jesus' miracle is a sign which anticipates his teaching that is to come, that He alone is the "bread of life" to whom people can come and never again hunger.

It is time to begin thinking about RCIA. In a few weeks we will return to weekly sessions of RCIA for those considering entrance into the Catholic faith. The first several months of RCIA are considered a period of "Inquiry" when participants have a chance to learn more about the Catholic faith without making any specific commitments. If you or someone you know are interested in starting in the RCIA, please contact Deacon Terry or Ann Gage.

Finally, this week (July 29 - August 2) I will be on **Vacation**. Each day I will be here for 8 a.m. Daily Mass but will be unavailable the rest of the day.


# 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time




