FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The last couple of weeks have been rather chaotic in our national news. We saw the news of the assassination attempt on the former president at a campaign rally, and then the current president withdraw from the presidential race. The Archbishop recently called on us to pray for our country and in particular for peace in our political discourse. The Archdiocese sent out a prayer for civil discourse in our country. I prayed that prayer at the 10:00 a.m. Mass a couple of Sundays ago. Several people asked where they could find that prayer. I am sharing it with the whole parish so that we can all pray for our nation, and call on God's mercy for us, especially in this election year. I ask all the parish to pray, to seek the will of God, to foster His peace in our hearts and to exemplify Christian charity for all our neighbors. While we have a civic duty to engage in our electoral processes, we must always do so with the help of God's grace, and resist any temptation to deify one party or candidate or demonize others. Christ is King, and only His peace can bring us true peace in our society and nation. So please join me in praying for our nation.
