## FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Last weekend we hosted the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage. It was a very powerful event, and we not only hosted the pilgrims who are accompanying the Blessed Sacrament across the country, we saw many people from the Archdiocese join us. Many of these visitors told me they had never been to the Cathedral, and they were very impressed by the beauty of the church, the kindness of the parishioners, and the reverence of our parish family. On June 28 we had a Eucharistic Procession from Donnelly College to the Cathedral, witness talks with praise and worship, all-night adoration, and a Mass on June 29 to conclude the events. It was a very powerful experience.

So many people helped to make this event possible. I offer a special thanks to the Knights of Columbus who hosted the dinner on the evening of June 28, to the musicians who showed up to offer their gifts and talents to our time of adoration and Mass, to the Sister Servants of Mary who offered witness talks and accompanied us through the whole program, to the deacons who assisted in liturgical preparations, to Michael Rebout who helped organize and guide the procession we had, and to Denise and Clarissa in our office, who did so much to assist with this event, and to the many parishioners who participated in the event. A very special thank you goes to Val Lobatos who did so much planning for months before the event. Val was the liaison between the parish and the Archdiocese, and who spent so much time to make sure this event was a success. This event would not have happened at the Cathedral had Val not been so dedicated in organizing it.

While our hosting of the pilgrimage has concluded, and the National Eucharistic Congress will be happening from July 17-21 in Indianapolis, the work of our Eucharistic Revival is far from over. We will have another year of focus on the Eucharist, and how we can better integrate the grace of the Eucharist into our lives and put our relationship with the Lord into practice in how we interact with others. We will also continue to look for ways to enhance our engagement with the Eucharist in our liturgies and in the devotional life here in the parish. Someone mentioned to me that it would be nice if we could bring back the 40 Hours devotion to the Cathedral. We will certainly be looking at that and consider when would be the best time of year to offer this beautiful devotion.

Thank you all for your participation in the various elements of the Eucharistic Revival, and especially in your participation in the life of the parish. All the goodness our visitors saw in our parish is because of you and your beautiful faith and your response to this great initiative.

El fin de semana pasado participamos en la Peregrinación Eucarística Nacional. También continuaremos buscando maneras de mejorar nuestro compromiso con la Eucaristía en nuestras liturgias y en la vida devocional aquí en la parroquia. Alguien me mencionó que sería bueno que pudiéramos recuperar la devoción de las 40 Horas en la Catedral. Seguramente lo analizaremos y consideraremos cuándo sería el mejor tiempo del año para ofrecer esta hermosa devoción.

Gracias a todos por su participación en los diversos elementos del Avivamiento Eucarístico, y especialmente en su participación en la vida de la parroquia. Toda la bondad que nuestros visitantes vieron en nuestra parroquia se debe a ustedes, su hermosa fe y su respuesta a esta gran iniciativa.
