Pastor's Letter

August 18, 2024—20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me." (John 6:57)

Dear Church Family,

Some would have us believe that the only way to survive in this world is to follow the law of the jungle; kill or be killed, eat or be eaten. If I am going to live, something else has to die. This is the wisdom of the world after its fall from grace. And this attitude has wormed its way into our understanding of how human interactions work. We often feel that if someone else wins, I lose. Hyper-competitiveness makes us see everything as a zero-sum game. We can't celebrate others success because it might make us look or feel inferior. We can't enjoy real and healthy competition because of the pressure to win.

Jesus offers us a different way. The resurrected life of Jesus is not diminished by his sharing it with us. In fact, it is enhanced and multiplied the more he shares it. In our Gospel reading for today, Jesus says that the life that is in him has come directly from the Father who is the source of life. By our participation in Christ by partaking of his body and blood in the Eucharist that same life flows into us.

Those who crucified Jesus thought that by doing so they were bringing to an end this new kind of life that challenged their power. But the life that filled Christ cannot be extinguished. The resurrection proved that. Not only is Christ alive eternally, but when we are in communion with him so are we. The Wisdom of God and God's law of life and love has overcome the "wisdom" of the world and the law of the jungle.


