




St. Maximilian Kolbe | Catholic Saints



Mission Appeal for the Archdiocese of Mwanza in Tanzania Rev. Fr. Yohana Shija Masalu Weekend of August 31—September 1, 2024

The Archdiocese of Mwanza is found in the Northwestern part of Tanzania, which is among the Eastern African countries. Hence our neighboring countries are Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, Mozambique, Malawi, Zambia, and Congo. Tanzania is also where you can find the tallest mountain in Africa and the second worldwide- the so-called Kilimanjaro.

The Archdiocese's primary projects:

Priestly Formation: Currently, we have 100 major seminarians who are taking theology. It costs \$ 1,000 per seminarian to cover his tuition fees, transportation costs, accommodation, and health insurance. Hence, we are in need of \$ 100,000. Our local people are very generous. They donate to help. However, they are limited because of extreme poverty in our area.

Education Project: In our area, education is more given to boys than girls. Hence segregation. Due to poverty, parents prefer their daughters to get married in exchange for cows/dowry. Girls are just instrumentalized and used as a source of income. As the church, we don't accept this. We believe in and fight for equality. Thus, we are currently building primary and secondary schools for girls so that we can equip/empower them with education.

Water Project: Most of the people in the remote area share drinking water with livestock and other animals. That water is polluted. As a result, many people are dying due to unclean and unsafe water consumption. As the church, we don't want to remain indifferent to our human beings created in the image and likeness of God. Thus, right now, we are drilling 3 deep wells and boreholes to supply these people with pure drinking water. One well costs about **\$8,000**.


