From the Pastor's desk....


A reminder for when a loved one is cremated: The cremains are not to be scattered or divided up. The cremains are to be buried or properly interred. It is prohibited to scatter ashes or to divide up ashes to be dispersed or made into jewelry. With the increasing number of cremations taking place, there are more and more creative things happening with regard to the cremains of a person. We must remember that a person's body is sacred. We are created in the image and likeness of God. Our body is a sacred temple here on earth that carries our soul. Whether we turn to dust slowly—or if the process is sped up through cremation, we are to remember that this was a person who walked the earth and the utmost respect needs to be maintained after death.

Please remember to mark Saturday, September 14, on your calendar as we gather at Montini Catholic High School at 4:00. This will be a DuPage County-wide event with our bishop as we celebrate mass for the 75th Anniversary of the Diocese of Joliet. After mass there will be an opportunity for fellowship. Registration for RE is ongoing. We welcome new students in all grades, first through eighth. Faith formation is an essential ministry of the Church and open to all those who are baptized or wish to be baptized. It doesn't end with the reception of a sacrament but continues just as our faith-life continues. Each year, the children learn more about

the beauty of our faith as they deepen their relationship with God. Parents are the primary educators in matters of faith but our catechists can extend and develop what happens in our homes, the domestic church.

Registration forms can also be found on the parish website under "Formation". You can also email Loretta Crotty at loretta@ctklombard.org to receive one.

Our classes are for students in grades 1 through 8. Grades 1-6 meet on Wednesdays from 6:30 to 7:45 p.m. or on Sundays from 8:45 to 9:45 a.m. Seventh and eighth grade meet only during the Sunday sessions. Classes will begin on Sunday, September 8 and Wednesday, September 11.

Our catechists are devoted to sharing their faith with their students and committed to the ongoing formation of the future of our Church.

Children receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in second grade but the expectation is that they will attend class for two years; both first and second grade. Confirmation is conferred in eighth grade but the preparation process begins in seventh grade as a two year program.


Silver Rose is Coming to Christ the King Wednesday, August 28


