As you are aware, our diocese is in a period of Restructuring Parishes. Demographics change. Not as many people are attending mass or are actively involved in parish life as they did years ago. In an effort to use resources wisely, our Diocese of Joliet has been active the last number of years looking at many things; including our Chancery and the local parishes.

We have 2 very important dates for you. These are meetings that will allow you to listen and to speak about possible changes coming to our parish of Christ the King. Saturday, September 28 & Saturday, November 2. We will meet in the church from 9:00-11:00.

The first meeting we will be presented with diocesan-wide data. The second meeting we will be presented with possible scenarios. Then, the weekend before Thanksgiving, we will provide written feedback on the possible scenarios. In February, Bishop Hicks makes his decision, and all decisions are publicly announced and published in parish bulletins. July 1, all changes go into effect.

More information will be given to you as I receive it. Please keep your prayer life active at this time!

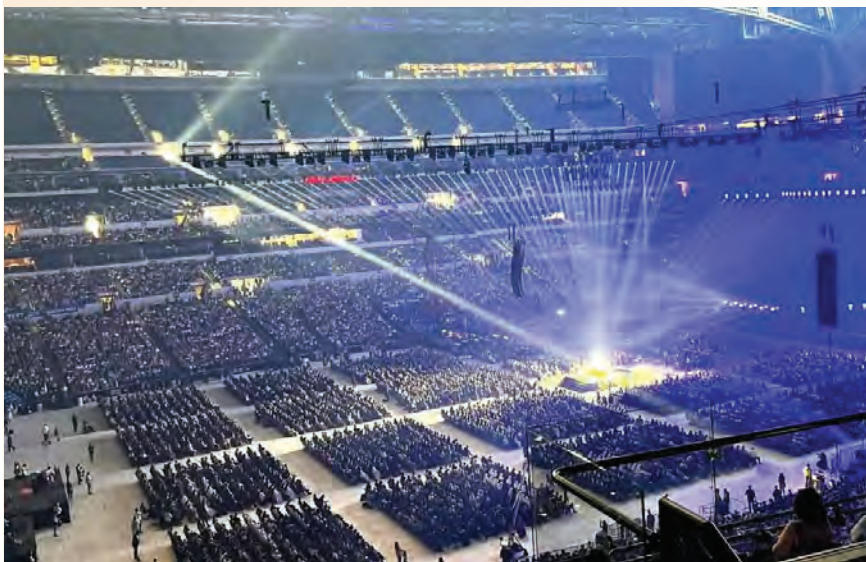

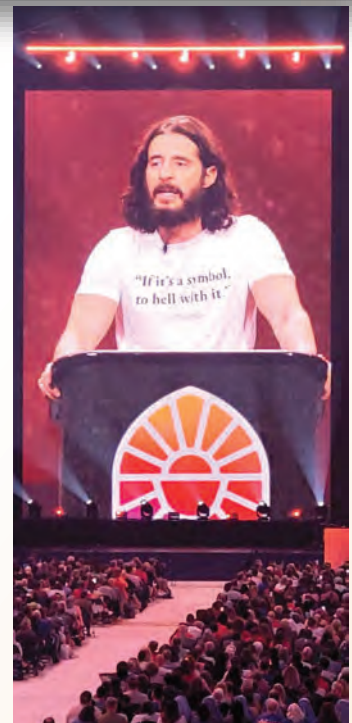
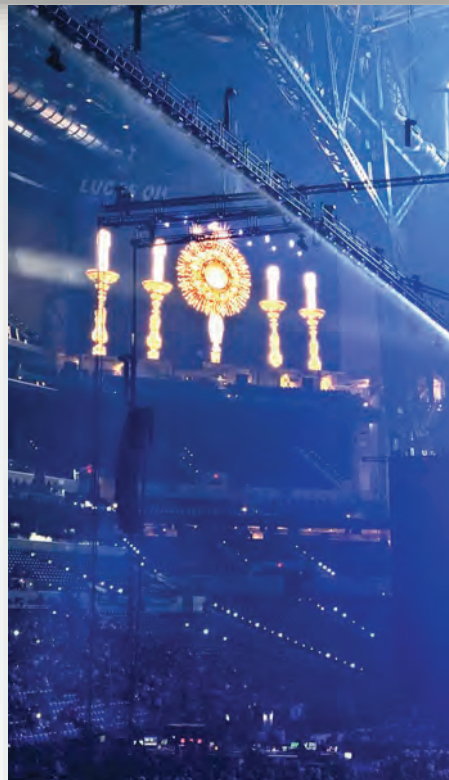

Silver Rose is Coming to Christ the King

The History of the Silver Rose

Our Lady of Guadalupe did so much for her people in Mexico that, in 1960, the Columbian Squires, a youth organization of the Knights of Columbus, wanted to give something back to her. The group of young men in Knights of Columbus Council 2312 in Monterrey, Mexico, came up with the idea of running a rose to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico.



The rose was chosen to commemorate Juan Diego and the miracle of the roses, an important part of the story of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The first rose was a natural rose and was blessed by Bishop John C. Cody of London. It was then flown to New York where it was received by Grand Knight Joseph Thomasen, who in turn, took it to Supreme Knight Luke E. Hart. Mr. Hart then shepherded the rose to Dallas, Texas. There, Texas State Deputy Jack Collerin received the rose and took it to Laredo, Texas, where it was finally given to the Squires from Monterrey, Mexico, at the International Bridge in Laredo. They ran the rose from the International Bridge through Sabinas Hidalgo N.L., Mexico, to Cienega de Flores and on to the Basilica in Monterrey, Mexico, on December 12, 1960.
