#### From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 24<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the gospel story this weekend we hear the climactic moment in Mark's narrative when Peter proclaims Jesus as the Messiah and Christ. All of Jesus' miracles and exorcisms have led Peter to the conviction that Jesus truly is the awaited Messiah. Yet Peter is not prepared for what kind of messiah with which our Lord is identifying. Jesus will be a messiah who must suffer. How is the suffering in my own life leading me to the Messiah?

This weekend (September 14/15) is Catechetical Sunday. This weekend the universal Church recognizes and blesses all those involved in sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ in many varied parish and school ministries. And thanks to all who have and continue to donate to QCES for the Tuition Assistance needs of Catholic families throughout our Quincy area. Thank you QCES!

Finally, I want to express our gratitude for all those who helped with last Saturday's Septemberfest. The Lord gave us great weather, and we had a great turnout from the parish and local community. I would like to thank all those who volunteered in many different capacities for Septemberfest. Many parish and school volunteers worked countless hours in preparation, set-up, and clean up after the event. Thanks especially to our very generous corporate sponsors of the event. Thanks to all those who made donations to the Silent Auction, and to those who baked cakes and pies. Thanks to our 8<sup>th</sup> Grade students and parents who coordinated the Kids Zone. Special thanks to our Boy Scouts who helped throughout the evening, especially during our 11:00 p.m. time of clean-up. Finally, thanks to our entire Septemberfest Committee and my fellow Co-Chairs Amy Zanger and Matt Schmidt who brought our parish members' many talents together. I am very proud of our parish's wonderful work at this year's Septemberfest.
