FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In my homily last weekend I mentioned the next step in our Eucharistic Revival is the “Walk with One” initiative. I thought it might be useful to offer the steps of our call to “Walk with One” as a reminder for those who were at my Masses, and to share them with those who were at Fr. Cordes’ Masses last weekend. These points are from the National Eucharistic Revival website. It is a great layout of how we can go about sharing our faith, sharing the gift of the Eucharist, and sharing this powerful encounter we have with the Lord with others. There are four points, and I will highlight each one for four weeks, so that we have a clear understanding of how we might be able to put this into practice.

The first of the four steps is to Identify someone in a spirit of prayer and humility. Prayerfully begin to discern whom God is calling you to accompany. We all have someone or several people in our family, social, and work circles who maybe has lost the practice of the faith, or who has never experienced it. There is no shortage of people who can encounter the Lord through us. But don’t just pick someone. Ask God whom he wants you to accompany on their journey home to the Church. You may get several ideas of who it is. Pray with each one to discern with the Lord who He is calling you to engage. He will point you to the person he has in mind and open doors for the conversations that need to happen. Before you begin the process of inviting someone into a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church, spend time in prayer, inviting the Holy Spirit to guide you in this process. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you the person that he wants you to accompany. Consider going to Eucharistic adoration or committing to a period of silent prayer in a church to allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you.

Next week I will highlight the second step. But I encourage you to begin now with this prayerful discernment. Start thinking of and praying for the guidance of the Holy Spirit about who it is you are to engage. If you can stop by the chapel on Tuesdays for some time in adoration, this would be a great way to discern with the Lord. I also encourage you to incorporate this discernment into your daily prayer. This evangelizing, to share the Lord and our Faith, to extend the grace we receive into the world, is part of our call as Catholics, and a necessary consequence of our own receptions of Our Lord’s body, blood, soul, and divinity. This may seem intimidating, but we must remember, we are not alone. He is with us, and will accompany us every step of them. This will be a powerful way for us to take ownership of our faith, and fulfill our mission to bring others to Christ.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

En mi homilía del fin de semana pasado mencioné que el próximo paso en nuestro Avivamiento Eucarístico es la iniciativa “Caminar con Uno” o “Camina con alguien”. Pensé que podría ser útil ofrecer los pasos de nuestro llamado a “Caminar con Uno” como recordatorio para la comunidad. Estos puntos son del sitio web del Avivamiento Eucarístico Nacional. Es un excelente esquema de cómo podemos compartir nuestra fe, compartir el don de la Eucaristía y compartir este poderoso encuentro que tenemos con el Señor con los demás. Hay cuatro puntos, y destacaré cada uno durante cuatro semanas, para que tengamos una comprensión clara de cómo podemos poner esto en práctica.

El primero de los cuatro pasos es identificar a alguien en un espíritu de oración y humildad. Con oración, comience a discernir a quien lo está llamando Dios a acompañar. Todos tenemos a alguien o varias personas en nuestro círculo familiar, social y laboral que tal vez han perdido la práctica de la fe, o que nunca la han experimentado. No faltan personas que pueden encontrarse con el Señor a través de nosotros. Pero no elijas a alguien sin más. Pregúntale a Dios a quién quiere que acompañes en su viaje de regreso a la Iglesia. Puedes tener varias ideas de quién puede ser. Ora con cada una para discernir con el Señor a quién te está llamando a relacionarte. Él te señalará a la persona que tiene en mente y abrirá puertas para las conversaciones que deben suceder. Antes de comenzar el proceso de invitar a alguien a una relación más profunda con Jesucristo y la Iglesia Católica, pasa tiempo en oración, invitando al Espíritu Santo a que te guíe en este proceso. Pídele al Espíritu Santo que te muestre a la persona que quiere que acompañes. Considera ir a la adoración eucarística o comprometerte a un período de oración silenciosa en una iglesia para permitir que el Espíritu Santo te hable.

La próxima semana destacaré el segundo paso. Pero te animo a comenzar ahora con este discernimiento en oración. Empiece a pensar y a orar para que el Espíritu Santo te guíe sobre con quiénes debe relacionarte. Si puedes pasar por la capilla los martes para un tiempo de adoración, sería una excelente manera de discernir con el Señor. También te animo a que incorpores este discernimiento en tu oración diaria. Evangelizar, compartir al Señor y nuestra fe, extender la gracia que recibimos al mundo es parte de nuestro llamado como católicos y una consecuencia necesaria de nuestra propia recepción del cuerpo, la sangre, el alma y la divinidad de Nuestro Señor. Esto puede parecer intimidante, pero debemos recordar que no estamos solos. Él está con nosotros y nos acompañará en cada paso. Esta será una manera poderosa de apropiarnos de nuestra fe y cumplir nuestra misión de llevar a otros a Cristo.
