

# Pastor's Letter

## September 15, 2024—24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it." Mark 8:35

Dear Church Family,

It is very fashionable to be rebellious today. Some see obedience as a sign of weakness. Freedom to do whatever I want whenever I want to and not be bound by morality or responsibility to others is seen as the greatest happiness.

Jesus shows us that the opposite is true. It is in losing ourselves in obedience to God and service to others that we find true and lasting happiness. My happiest moments are when I forget myself in the joy of communion with God or see the joy in another person's face over some small act of kindness I have done for them or gift I have given them.

This is what Jesus means when he says, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." If we want to be with Jesus where he is, in the place of God's peace and blessing, then we must follow the path that he walked, the path of obedience to God. That path led to the sacrifice of his life on the cross for us. Like him, we are called to give ourselves sacrificially for others and so participate in the great mystery of life and love in the Spirit, the paradoxical fact that the more we share our lives with others, the more the life of God lives in us and the more we love others, the more the love of God is poured into our hearts.

Her strong devotion to the Holy Spirit attracted many to the convent and was recognized for her great knowledge of the faith, music, natural science, herbs and medicinal arts.
