FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we continue to reflect on the “Walk with One” initiative of the Eucharistic Revival, we recall that last week I wrote that we are called to share the grace we receive and help others to encounter the Lord. In our first step, we are to ask the Lord to put someone on our hearts and minds, to inspire us regarding who it is that we are to engage. It is a matter of prayerfully discerning who He wants us to engage, not just who we can think of in our circles.

I hope that we have begun this process, to ask the Lord who it is He would like us to walk with and engage. If no one has come to mind yet, keep praying about it! If we have felt the sense of who it is we are to walk with, the next step is to Intercede for that person in communion with the Holy Spirit. We pray for the grace to be able to accompany the person whom the Lord has laid on your heart. We are to commit to praying for them for a specific period of time, asking God to open the opportunity for a conversation. We are to pray for that person in any struggles he or she might be facing, in any particular brokenness or sin, and for the grace to overcome any obstacles that might impede this person from drawing closer to Jesus and exploring the Catholic faith more deeply.

We might consider offering a holy hour or a novena of prayer for that person. Perhaps that person could be our Communion intention, that we would offer our reception of the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ for that person as we intercede for him or her. This could be one time, or many times as we offer intercessory prayer. Maybe we can offer our inconveniences or any sufferings we have for that person.

However we choose to pray for the person the Lord has put into our hearts, this second step is to call the Holy Spirit and all His grace into our dynamic with that person, to help inspire that person to openness of heart, to help us with wisdom and prudence, so that it will be the Lord guiding the process, and not just us.

This is a beautiful way to walk with someone spiritually, to lean into the great treasury of grace that God makes available to us, and allow Him to be the guiding force behind our efforts, to bring others to encounter Him, and experience His love and peace.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Mientras continuamos reflexionando sobre la iniciativa “Camina con Alguien” del Avivamiento Eucarístico, recordamos que la semana pasada escribí que estamos llamados a compartir la gracia que recibimos y ayudar a otros a encontrarse con el Señor. En nuestro primer paso, debemos pedirle al Señor que ponga a alguien en nuestro corazón y mente, que nos inspire con respecto a quién debemos relacionarnos. Es una cuestión de discernir en oración con quién quiere Él que nos relacionemos, no solo con quién se nos ocurra en nuestro círculo.

Espero que hayamos comenzado este proceso, de preguntarle al Señor con quién le gustaría que camináramos y con quién nos relacionáramos. Si todavía no se nos ha ocurrido nadie, ¡sigamos orando!

Si hemos sentido con quién debemos caminar, el siguiente paso es interceder por esa persona en comunión con el Espíritu Santo. Oremos por la gracia de poder acompañar a la persona que el Señor ha puesto en nuestro corazón. Debemos comprometernos a orar por ella durante un período de tiempo específico, pidiendo a Dios que abra la oportunidad de una conversación. Debemos orar por esa persona en cualquier lucha que pueda estar enfrentando, en cualquier quebrantamiento o pecado en particular, y por la gracia de superar cualquier obstáculo que pueda impedir que esta persona se acerque más a Jesús y explore la fe católica más profundamente.

Podríamos considerar ofrecer una hora santa o una novena de oración por esa persona. Tal vez esa persona podría ser nuestra intención de Comunión, que ofreceríamos nuestra recepción del Cuerpo, la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de Cristo por esa persona mientras intercedemos por él o ella. Esto podría ser una vez, o muchas veces mientras ofrecemos oración de intercesión. Tal vez podamos ofrecer nuestros inconvenientes o cualquier sufrimiento que tengamos por esa persona. Sea cual sea la forma en que elijamos orar por la persona que el Señor ha puesto en nuestro corazón, este segundo paso es invocar al Espíritu Santo y toda Su gracia en nuestra dinámica con esa persona, para ayudar a inspirar a esa persona a abrir su corazón, para ayudarnos con sabiduría y prudencia, para que sea el Señor quien guíe el proceso, y no solo nosotros.

Esta es una hermosa manera de caminar con alguien espiritualmente, de apoyarnos en el gran tesoro de gracia que Dios pone a nuestra disposición y permitirle que sea la fuerza que guíe nuestros esfuerzos, para llevar a otros a encontrarse con Él y experimentar Su amor y Su paz.
