

Respect Life Weekend, October 5/6. Our Church's annual memorial of the Gift, Right, and Responsibility to Life for the Unborn comes our way the first weekend in October. Not only that: the readings for the weekend address the sacredness of Marriage in the order of God's creation and Jesus' radical teaching on divorce. About this time last year, we offered a sermon on the difference between the Church's teaching as objective (what the Church teaches in the name of Jesus Christ), but also as subjective (the reality of persons, their circumstances, their state of mind, and the compassion & understanding needed in difficult situations). We talked about that; hope you remember it. We don't lower the bar on offering understanding and refraining from rash judgment; but we don't lower the bar on the Lord's teaching, either.

**Spanish Mass, October 13, 5 p.m., at ICC.** We're thinking about an outdoor Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, with games for the kids afterwards! Let's see whether the weather holds out for us. We'll be able to tell you more, next weekend.
