

I want to express my deepest gratitude to all parishioners from all five Catholic parishes in Hancock County, who have extended to me during and after my surgery, your heartfelt prayers, support, and love. My recovery after my back surgery will take some time. I, along with my eight siblings, inherited from our mother osteoarthritis. Many of my siblings including myself have had knee joint and hip replacements. As a result of my osteoarthritis, I have spinal stenosis, which is the thinning of the spinal cord. The past two years have been a roller coaster of lower back pain in my lumbar area of my back. Multiple steroids shots, physical therapy, and many visits for chiropractic adjustments have brought temporarily relief from pain, unfortunately these conservative procedures and treatment have not given me full relief of pain and as a result, have restricted or prevented me from enjoying my physical activities at work or during my hobbies: golf, fishing, and hunting. Hopefully, I will see some relief soon and will be able to resume my priestly ministry and enjoy my hobbies without physical pain. I also want to thank Fr. Tony during this past year for his sensitivity, support and friendship. Please know of my continued prayers for you and all of your families as we look forward to a brighter tomorrow! God Bless. Fr.
