FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Brothers and Sisters,

Each October, the Church celebrates Respect Life Month. It is helpful that we have this observance each year to remind ourselves of the dignity of each and every human being, no matter their stage of development and no matter what ‘worth’ society might put on status or capability. Each person is made in the image and likeness of God. Each person is uniquely and wonderfully made. Even if we struggle to understand a stage of development or a person’s quality of life, that person is precious in the eyes of our Creator, and has a destiny in eternity.

We know that our world promotes abortion, and more places are supporting euthanasia. The world celebrates our capacity to end human life, and it is so comfortable celebrating such darkness. We truly live in a society that, as St. John Paul II put it, is a culture of death. We have such a gift in our life, and we have an obligation to promote and proclaim the dignity of human life. The Church has developed so many initiatives to support those who are struggling, those who feel lost, and maybe that they have no choice but to embrace the culture of death. I think of the “Walking with Mom’s in Need” initiative, which equips parishes to accompany moms in crisis pregnancy and support them in choosing life. I think of the crisis pregnancy centers in our region, and adoption agencies which offer help to moms. I think of Catholic Hospice, and the Sister Servants of Mary, who offer care and support to people and their families at the end of life and in great sickness. We have such a gift to share with the world, and the capacity build a culture of life.

While every person has free will, and may choose to reject what the Church offers, this does not diminish our responsibility to witness to human life and do all that we can in our particular vocations to preach this good news to those around us. Our crisis pregnancy centers need support and help to get the word out that they can help moms in need. We can help those at the end of life to find Catholic Hospice, especially here in the Archdiocese at Villa St. Francis, to have catholic care that respects human life. We can raise our concern for the unborn, the elderly, the infirm when people speak of elections and ballot initiatives. We can pray all the more for an end to assaults on human life, and for a greater culture of life in our nation and world. One way to prayerfully witness is to join the Mass for Life and rosary walk on third Saturdays at Christ the King here in Kansas City. The Mass begins at 8:00 a.m., followed by a rosary procession to the abortion center on Leavenworth Road. It usually concludes around 10:00 a.m. There is also need of volunteers in the Church’s healing ministry, walking with post-abortive moms in Project Rachel, to help them heal from their tragic experience of abortion.

However we may discern the way we can better witness to the gift of human life, I ask that everyone truly consider how we each can better proclaim the Gospel of Life here in Kansas City. We are voices for the voiceless, and we are “our brother’s keeper”. Let us not be afraid to shine the light of Christ in this world that is so filled with darkness. Cada octubre, la Iglesia celebra el Mes del Respeto a la Vida. Es útil que celebremos esta celebración cada año para recordarnos la dignidad de todos y cada uno de los seres humanos, sin importar su etapa de desarrollo y sin importar el “valor” que la sociedad pueda otorgar a su estatus o capacidad. Cada persona está hecha a imagen y semejanza de Dios. Cada persona está hecha de manera única y maravillosa. Incluso si nos cuesta entender una etapa de desarrollo o la calidad de vida de una persona, esa persona es preciosa a los ojos de nuestro Creador y tiene un destino en la eternidad.

Sabemos que nuestro mundo promueve el aborto y muchos lugares apoyan la eutanasia. El mundo celebra nuestra capacidad de poner fin a la vida humana y se siente muy cómodo celebrando esa oscuridad. Realmente vivimos en una sociedad que, como dijo San Juan Pablo II, es una cultura de muerte. Tenemos un gran don en nuestra vida y tenemos la obligación de promover y proclamar la dignidad de la vida humana. La Iglesia ha desarrollado muchas iniciativas para apoyar a quienes están luchando, a quienes se sienten perdidos y tal vez no tienen otra opción que abrazar la cultura de la muerte. Pienso en la iniciativa “Caminando con mamás necesitadas”, que equipa a las parroquias para acompañar a las mamás en crisis de embarazo y apoyarlas en la elección de la vida. Pienso en los centros de crisis de embarazo de nuestra región y en las agencias de adopción que ofrecen ayuda a las mamás. Pienso en el Hospicio Católico y en las Hermanas Siervas de María, que ofrecen atención y apoyo a las personas y sus familias al final de la vida y en una gran enfermedad. Tenemos un gran don para compartir con el mundo y la capacidad de construir una cultura de la vida.

Si bien cada persona tiene la libertad y puede elegir rechazar lo que ofrece la Iglesia, esto no disminuye nuestra responsabilidad de dar testimonio de la vida humana y hacer todo lo que podamos en nuestras vocaciones particulares para predicar esta buena noticia a quienes nos rodean. Nuestros centros de crisis de embarazo necesitan apoyo y ayuda para difundir la información de que pueden ayudar a las mamás necesitadas. Podemos ayudar a quienes están al final de su vida a encontrar un hospicio católico, especialmente aquí en la Arquidiócesis en Villa St. Francis, para recibir atención católica que respete la vida humana. Podemos expresar nuestra preocupación por los no nacidos, los ancianos, los enfermos cuando la gente habla de elecciones e iniciativas electorales. Podemos orar aún más por el fin de los ataques a la vida humana y por una mayor cultura de la vida en nuestra nación y en el mundo. Una forma de dar testimonio con oración es unirse a la Misa por la Vida y la caminata del rosario los terceros sábados en Cristo Rey aquí en Kansas City. La Misa comienza a las 8:00 am, seguida de una procesión del rosario hasta el centro de abortos en Leavenworth Road. Por lo general, concluye alrededor de las 10:00 am. También se necesitan voluntarios en el ministerio de sanación de la Iglesia, para caminar en el Proyecto Raquel con las madres que han abortado, para ayudarlas a sanar de su trágica experiencia del aborto.

Independientemente de cómo podamos discernir la forma en que podemos dar un mejor testimonio del don de la vida humana, pido que todos consideren realmente cómo podemos proclamar mejor el Evangelio de la Vida aquí en Kansas City. Somos la voz de los que no la tienen y somos “los guardianes de nuestro hermano”. No tengamos miedo de hacer brillar la luz de Cristo en este mundo tan lleno de oscuridad. KANSAS CATHOLICS, POLITICS AND THE 2024 ELECTION

Catholics are called to Faithful Citizenship, which includes voting. How do we apply our faith and a properly formed conscience to the policy issues of the day as well as our choices for elected office? These are timely and important questions as every seat in the Kansas Senate and House is up for election this year. Members of the Kansas Catholic Conference (KCC), the public policy voice of the Kansas Catholic Bishops, are offering two special presentations designed to inform voters about key issues and where candidates stand. The first presentation is set for 7 p.m. on Monday, October 14 at St. Michael the Archangel Church parish hall in Leawood. A second presentation is being offered at 7 p.m. on Monday, October 21 at St. Patrick's Church parish hall in Kansas City. These presentations will cover what happened this past legislative session at the Kansas Statehouse and information about candidate surveys commissioned by the KCC will be distributed. There will also be time for questions and answers. Please come to help become better informed as you prepare to vote.


