

The New Name for our Newly Aligned Parish: First Round of Voting This Weekend! We hope that you have given thought and prayer to the new name for our newly aligned parish. Once again, by way of explanation: Sts. Peter and Paul, Immaculate Conception, and Sacred Heart Warsaw Churches retain their names as "sites" or "locations" where the single parish gathers for worship. The primary site is Sts. Peter and Paul; Immaculate Conception and Sacred Heart Warsaw Churches are "secondary sites," meaning that there is no guarantee for a full Mass schedule at these churches. (But we're going to have them. Distance, the difficulty in shifting from the way we've worked for the past twenty years, and riot control (!!!) all call for retaining a shared Mass schedule.) Our prayers, solidarity, and continuing efforts go out to our Dallas City and Hamilton churches; sorry that you even have to read this announcement, grateful that your interest in our school hasn't lessened or faded.
