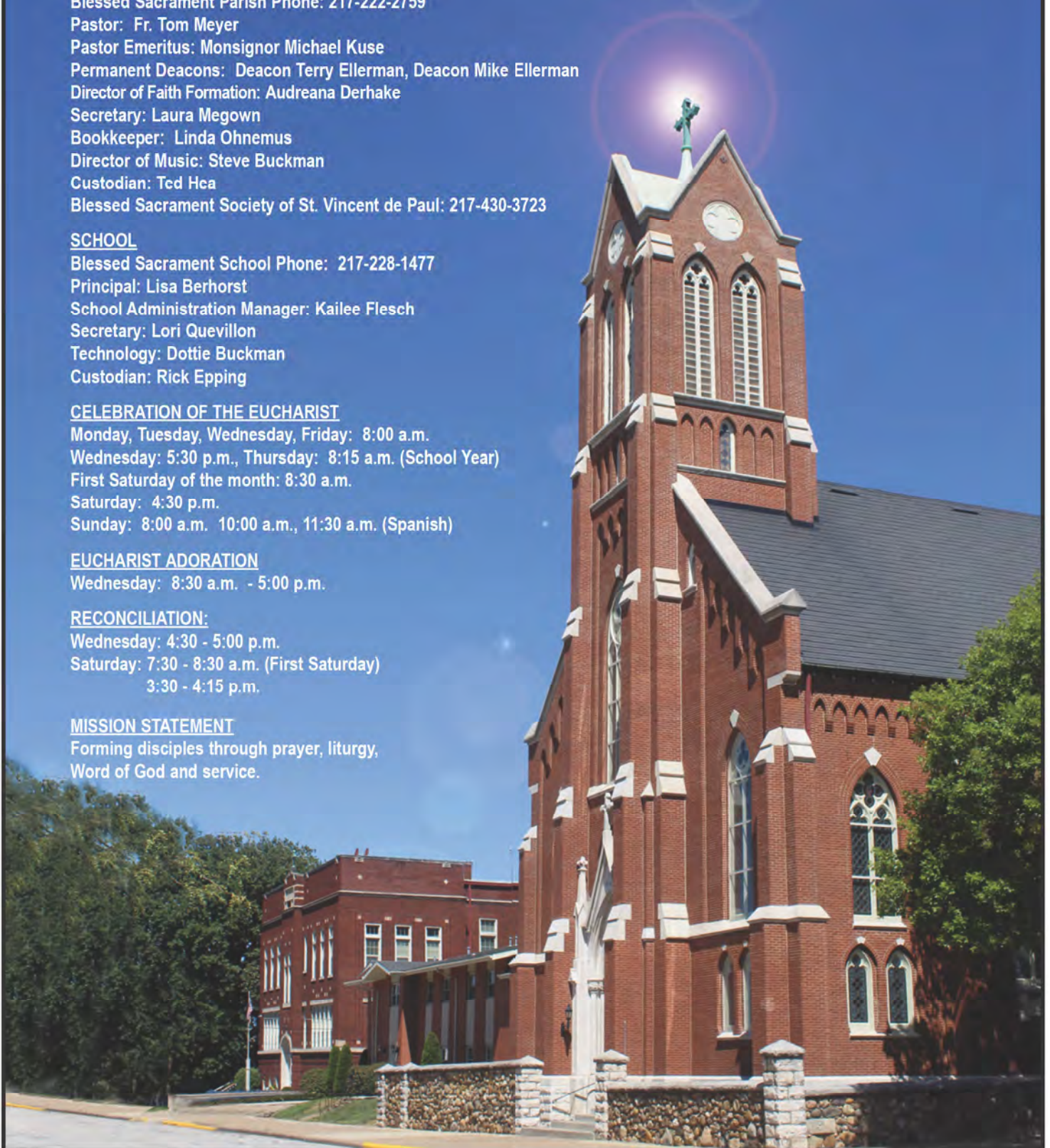

Today we celebrate the **31<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**. In the gospel story Jesus gives us the Two Great Commandments: Love of God and Love of Neighbor. All that is written in the Law and Prophets are summarized in these two great commandments. Importantly, we express our love for God by the *way* we love our neighbor. *Everything* we say and do (or neglect to do) expresses our love for God.

Last week was **Stewardship Commitment Sunday**. Thank you to everyone who filled out and submitted your Stewardship forms. If you have not yet turned in your form, you can do so online, or return your completed form to the designated location in the Gathering Space, or mail to the Parish Office. Thank you for discerning your gift of stewardship that you offer in love of Jesus and in support of the mission of Blessed Sacrament Parish.

This weekend our **QCES Foundation** will speak at all Masses about opportunities to help grow our foundation which provides Tuition Assistance to all of our Catholic Schools here in Quincy. This past year QCES provided **\$38,420** in Tuition Assistance dollars to our Blessed Sacrament School families. Please open your hearts to consider your own donation to QCES.

Next weekend (November 9-10) we will celebrate the **Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick** after all of our weekend Masses. We will offer this sacrament to anyone wishing to receive this sacramental anointing which brings healing to both body and soul.

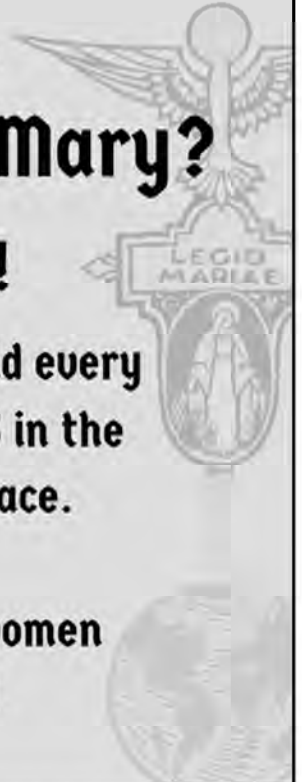
