FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Brothers and Sisters,

I am very excited that the physical work on the front steps is about to begin! As was announced at Masses last weekend, the main entrance of the church will be closed for the duration of the project. We are looking at a late-April/early-May completion date. During this time we will be limited to the side entrance on the south side of the church. While this is inconvenient, it will facilitate the work on the front steps, and come spring, we will have a magnificent entrance leading into the main doors. I am sorry for the inconvenience, but I also thank you for your patience. It has been a long process, especially waiting for the permits from the city, but it will soon be finished!

I also want to share with you a change in our office staff. Our music director, Stuart Taylor, will be leaving us this week. He has moved to Topeka and has accepted a position in a parish there. I am so grateful to Stuart for all of his dedication and service to the Sacred Liturgy here at the Cathedral and all his help to me. He is an accomplished musician and director of Sacred Music who has worked for the last few years in a parish in the Archdiocese and has experience leading music programs in Mexico. He is 100% bilingual and well versed in the liturgical music traditions in various languages. He also is gifted in forming choirs and teaching. He will be a great gift to us our diversity as a parish family.

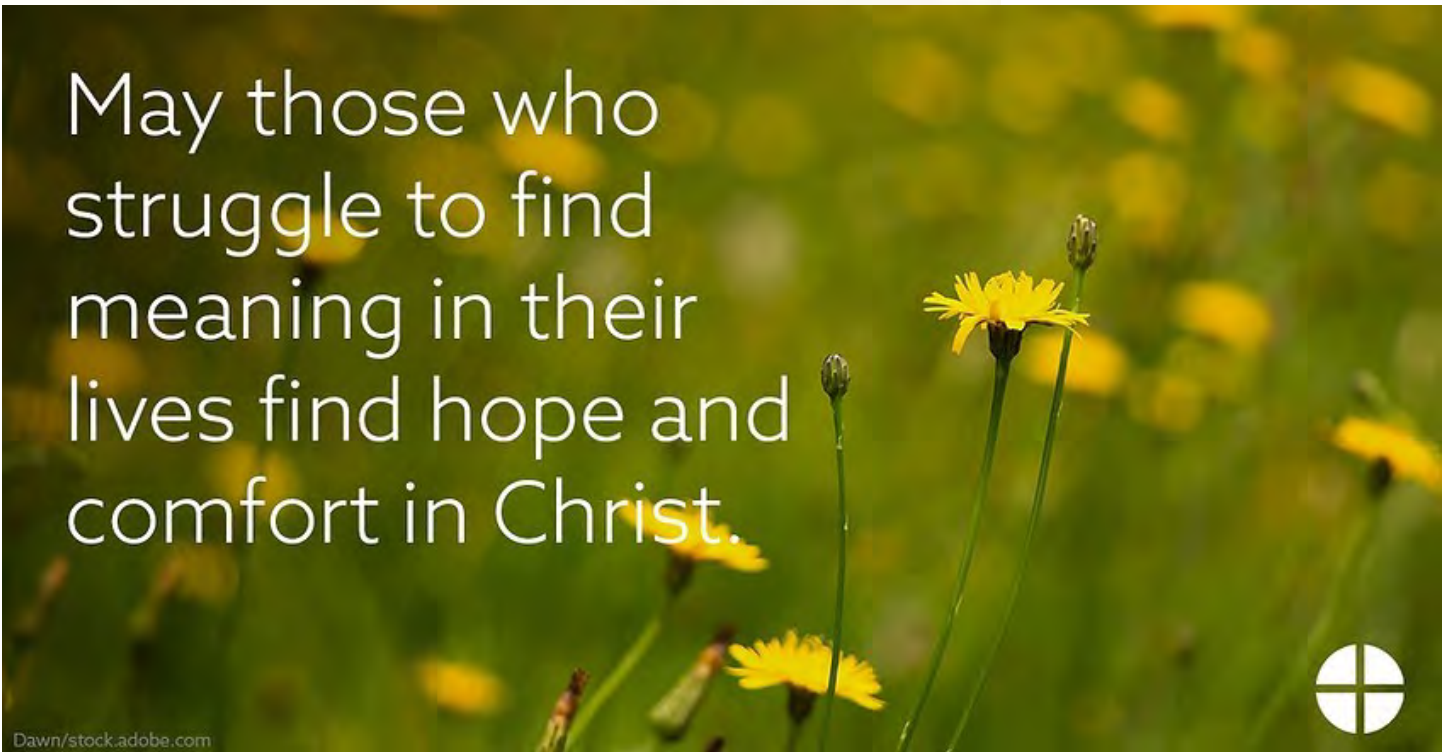
