Have we forgotten the flood and the calamitous times of the famine and war whose history has been recorded precisely in order to keep us from complaining to God on account of our own times?

Just think what those past ages were like! Is there one of us who does not shudder to hear or read of them? Far from justifying complaints about our own time, they teach us how much we have to be thankful for. - St. Augustine

Some people are never satisfied because they define happiness for themselves in terms of having more. Some one once asked J. D. Rockefeller "How much is enough."
