2. **Dawning Day Processing** (part of Homestyle Foods) - will take all deer - 217-322-7519 - 3024 N 1200th Ave., Clayton
3. **One Stop Butcher Shop** (previously Bowen Locker) - will take all deer - 309-333-7736 - 115 East 5th Street, Bowen

Please ask the hunters to tell the location to designate it for CFCAC. If someone is not a hunter, a donation of funds to our CFCAC Food Pantry would help defray these processing fees. If a monetary donation is given, please write in the memo line "deer processing."
