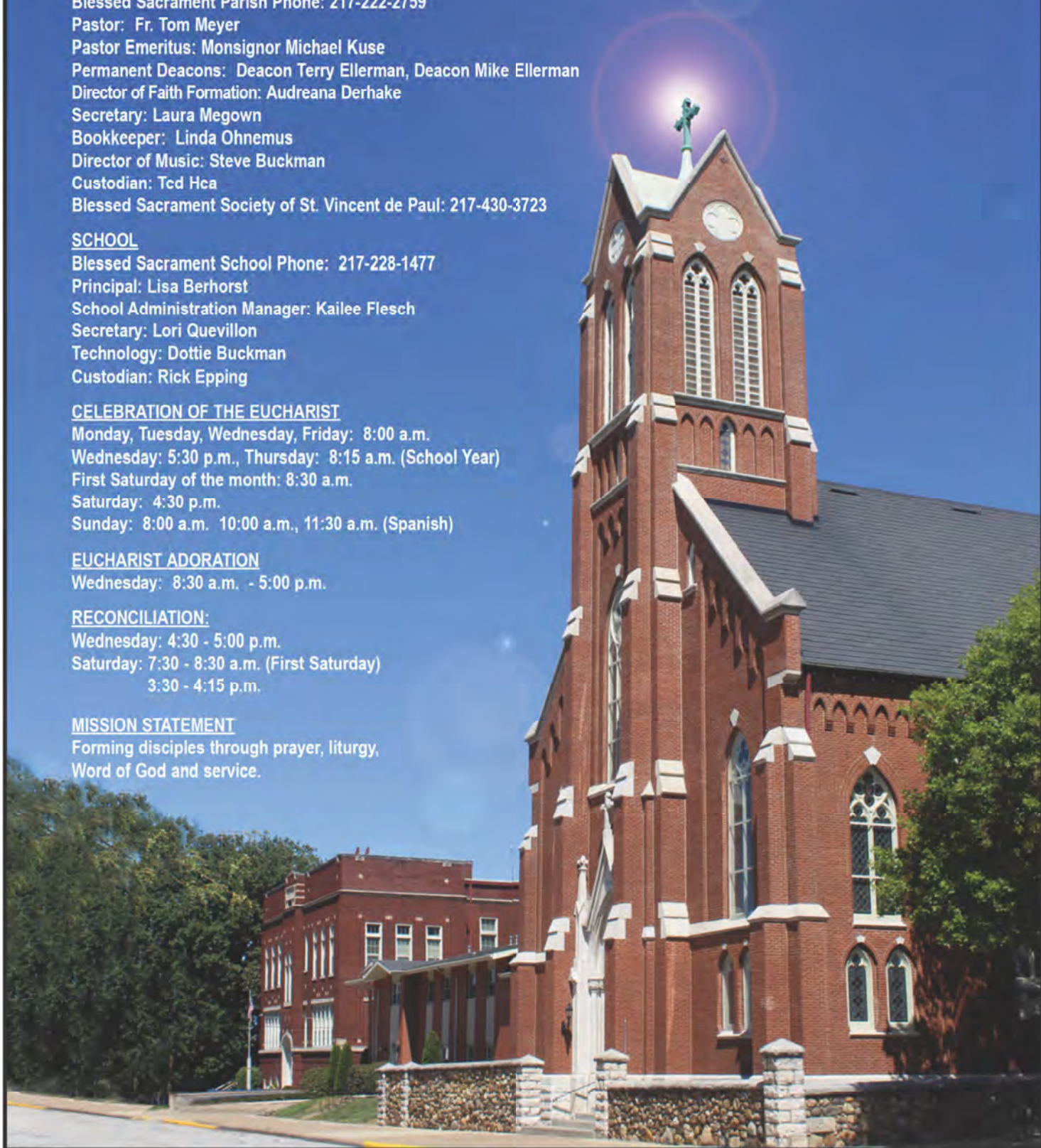

Today we celebrate the 33<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the gospel today we hear Jesus' description of the end times. "And then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory." There is great mystery about what Christ's final coming will look like. "Heaven and earth will pass away but my words will not pass away." Many things will be different after our Lord's Coming. Sin, suffering, and death will be gone; and our bodies will be glorified. Yet the essentials will remain the same...our everlasting love for Jesus Christ and one another.

Next weekend (November 23-24) is our **Annual Presentation for our St. Vincent De Paul Society**. This parish charitable organization disburses funds to help those in need throughout our parish and local community. St. Vincent De Paul will also provide their annual financial report in next weekend's bulletin.

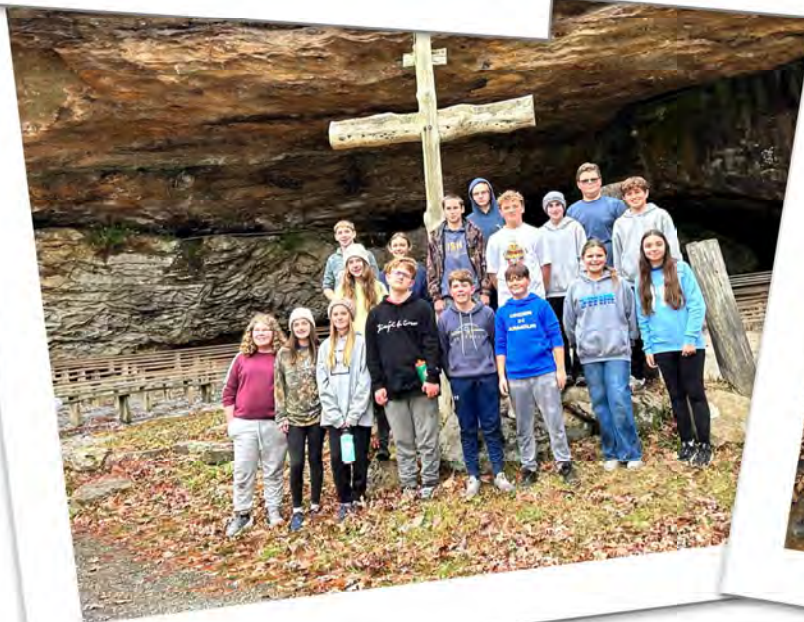

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With a population of over 1.1 million inhabitants, the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois has tens of thousands of people in our midst living in poverty. These men, women and children seldom make the headlines. However, their needs are real and deserve our prayer, action, and financial support.
