

Pastor's Letter

November 17, 2024—33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Church Family,

I'm always moved at this time of year when I walk into our churches and see the tables filled with pictures of our loved ones who have passed into their eternal reward. We remember them with love. We miss them, but our faith gives us hope that one day we can be reunited with them in Christ.






