

The Season of Advent. Our preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ on Christmas Day begins with the Advent season. Our faith enters into the remembrance of awaiting the Lord's *first* coming, as a pattern in which to be awake, alert, and prepared for the comings of Jesus Christ throughout our lives, as well as his *second* coming, at the end of time.

Advent Confession Times, Prior to Christmas Eve:

December 21, Saturday: SMH: after 5:30pm Mass, during the Healing Service this evening. December 22, Sunday: ICC, 11:00am to 1:00pm. SPPN: 6:00pm to 8:00pm. December 23, Monday: SHDC, 3:00pm to 5:00pm. SHW: 6:00pm to 8:00pm. Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Masses: Note: 3rd year of our rotation among the

churches still in effect.

December 24, Tuesday: SHDC, 4:00pm. SHW, 7:00pm; SMH, 10:00pm. December 25, Wednesday: SPPN, 8:00am; ICC, 10:00am.

Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. While we are dispensed from the obligation to celebrate the Mass on this day, we are encouraged to have more of a Mass schedule than we usually have. *Because December 8 falls on Sunday, the Second Sunday of Advent takes precedence over the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.* Therefore, Masses for the Immaculate Conception will take place on Monday, December 9, at the following times: SPPN, 8:00 a.m.; ICC, Noon; SHW, 5:30 p.m. Even if "we don't *have* to go to Mass," we might want to consider *wanting* to!

No Spanish Mass on December 8. We will have our annual Mass in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe on Thursday, December 12, at 5:30 p.m. Authentic Mexican food will be served in the parish hall following Mass. All are welcome!!!
