

Pastor's Letter

December 1, 2024—1st Sunday of Advent

Dear Church Family,

There are two main themes of the season of Advent, which begins today. The first is the theme of preparing ourselves for the return of Christ at the end of time, the Day of the Lord. God's promise to reconcile and renew all of Creation will finally be accomplished. The second theme of Advent is to prepare ourselves to celebrate the Nativity of the Lord. We remember with awe and wonder how the eternally begotten Son, the second person of the Holy Trinity took on human flesh and became a helpless, vulnerable little child so that the whole world might be redeemed by his sacrificial life, death, and resurrection.

The birth of Christ in Bethlehem was the beginning of the end of the world as we know it. We don't know when the final day will come, but it is coming, and the question is will we be ready? Jesus tells us to "Be watchful! Be alert!" We prepare ourselves for that day by carrying out the mission of telling the world about Christ and living out his love in the world. It was the love of God that brought Jesus from heaven and it is the love of God living in us, active in our love for him and for each other that will bring us to heaven.

As we look around us today, there is so much uncertainty and fear. We worry about environmental concerns, political and social upheaval, economic problems and more. These are real causes for concern and if we are truly living the love of God, we need to work together to address them for the good of all humankind and in witness to the goodness of God. But the Christian believer is not overwhelmed by fear because our hope is not in the world as it is, but in the world as it will be when Christ comes again, and the promises of God are fulfilled. The very things that tempt others to give in to despair are just reminders to the Christian of the impermanence of the current way of the world. We persevere in doing good and pursuing what is right in anticipation of our Lord's return. We stand tall and look up in hope because we know a better day and a better way are coming. "What I say to you, I say to all: Watch!"


Stewardship Reflection
