Today we celebrate the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Advent. In the gospel story today we hear the voice of the prophet John the Baptist. "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." During this season of Advent we look at the pathway we make for Christ's coming into our heart. The greatest obstacle we place in that pathway is sin. We ask the Lord of mercies to help us identify those obstacles, and through the Sacrament of Reconciliation we "make straight his path" to our heart.

Tomorrow (Monday, December 9) we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception**, which has been clarified by Rome to be a Holy Day of Obligation. We have 2 Masses available for your attendance tomorrow:
