

The Season of Advent. Our preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ on Christmas Day begins with the Advent season. Our faith enters into the remembrance of awaiting the Lord's *first* coming, as a pattern in which to be awake, alert, and prepared for the comings of Jesus Christ throughout our lives, as well as his *second* coming, at the end of time.

Advent Confession Times, Prior to Christmas Eve:

December 21, Saturday: SMH: after 5:30 p.m. Mass, during the Healing Service this evening. December 22, Sunday: ICC, 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. SPPN: 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. December 23, Monday: SHDC, 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. SHW: 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Masses: Note: 3rd year of our rotation among the churches still in effect.

December 24, Tuesday: SHDC, 4:00 p.m. SHW, 7:00 p.m.; SMH, 10:00 p.m. December 25, Wednesday: SPPN, 8:00 a.m.; ICC, 10:00 a.m.

Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. While we are dispensed from the obligation to celebrate the Mass on this day, we are encouraged to have more of a Mass schedule than we usually have. *Because December 8 falls on Sunday, the Second Sunday of Advent takes precedence over the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.* Therefore, Masses for the Immaculate Conception will take place on Monday, December 9, at the following times: SPPN, 8:00 a.m.; ICC, Noon; SHW, 5:30 p.m. Even if "we don't *have* to go to Mass," we might want to consider *wanting* to!

Our Lady of Guadalupe Bilingual Rosary Novena will be at Immaculate Conception Church in Carthage beginning on Tuesday, December 3 and ending on Wednesday, December 11. The time is 6:00 p.m. each evening except on 12/9 when it will be at 7:30 p.m. and on 12/11 when it will be in front of the Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine at 10:30 p.m. All are welcome!!!

Vigil of our Lady of Guadalupe will be celebrated in front of the Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine at Immaculate Conception Church in Carthage on Wednesday, December 11 from 10:00 p.m. to midnight. All are welcome to join our Spanish community in traditional songs, prayers, and the final night of the Rosary Novena which will be recited at 10:30 p.m. Please bring lawn chairs! Refreshments will follow in the parish hall.

No Spanish Mass on December 8. We will have our annual Mass in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe on Thursday, December 12, at 5:30 p.m. Authentic Mexican food will be served in the parish hall following Mass. All are welcome!!!

Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Mass This Thursday, December 12, at 5:30 p.m., at Immaculate Conception Church, Carthage! Followed by dinner and celebration at our Parish Center. The Mass is in the Spanish language; but the Mass is the Mass in any language. So much from which to benefit and to learn, from both cultures: without loss of our identity as the United States, or loss of renewal in both cultures. And our Popes have constantly reminded us: Our Lady of Guadalupe is an appearance of the Blessed Virgin Mary *for the people of the Americas of both continents.* Hope to see you there!
