## Thank You!

As Christmas wound down this past year, CTK Food Pantry gave the families we serve another reason for hope and joy. Thanks to the Christmas gift card program, which is sponsored by our parishioners, each family received gift cards from Target & Walmart of well above \$5,000. We were also able to give them Christmas hams and the holiday fixings from Northern IL Food Bank.

Thanks to your generosity we were able to provide just over \$60,000 in assistance for the 2,900 families that visited our pantry, accounting for 8,787 individuals served.

Included below is a breakdown of some of the expenses:

- > \$19,000 in rental/eviction assistance.
- > \$38,500 in Aldi gift cards to assist in providing what we were unable to at the time.
- > \$2,700 in utility expense assistance.
- > \$4,750 in miscellaneous operating expenses, supplies, etc.

None of this happens without the generosity of our parish of Christ the King. I hope that this enlightens you as to what your donations are providing. The pantry volunteers and I are overwhelmed by your continuing generosity.

Coming **February 27, 2025 is our CCW/Knights Bingo night.**Save the date...more information to come!


# The "Holy Sacrifice Of The Mass"




