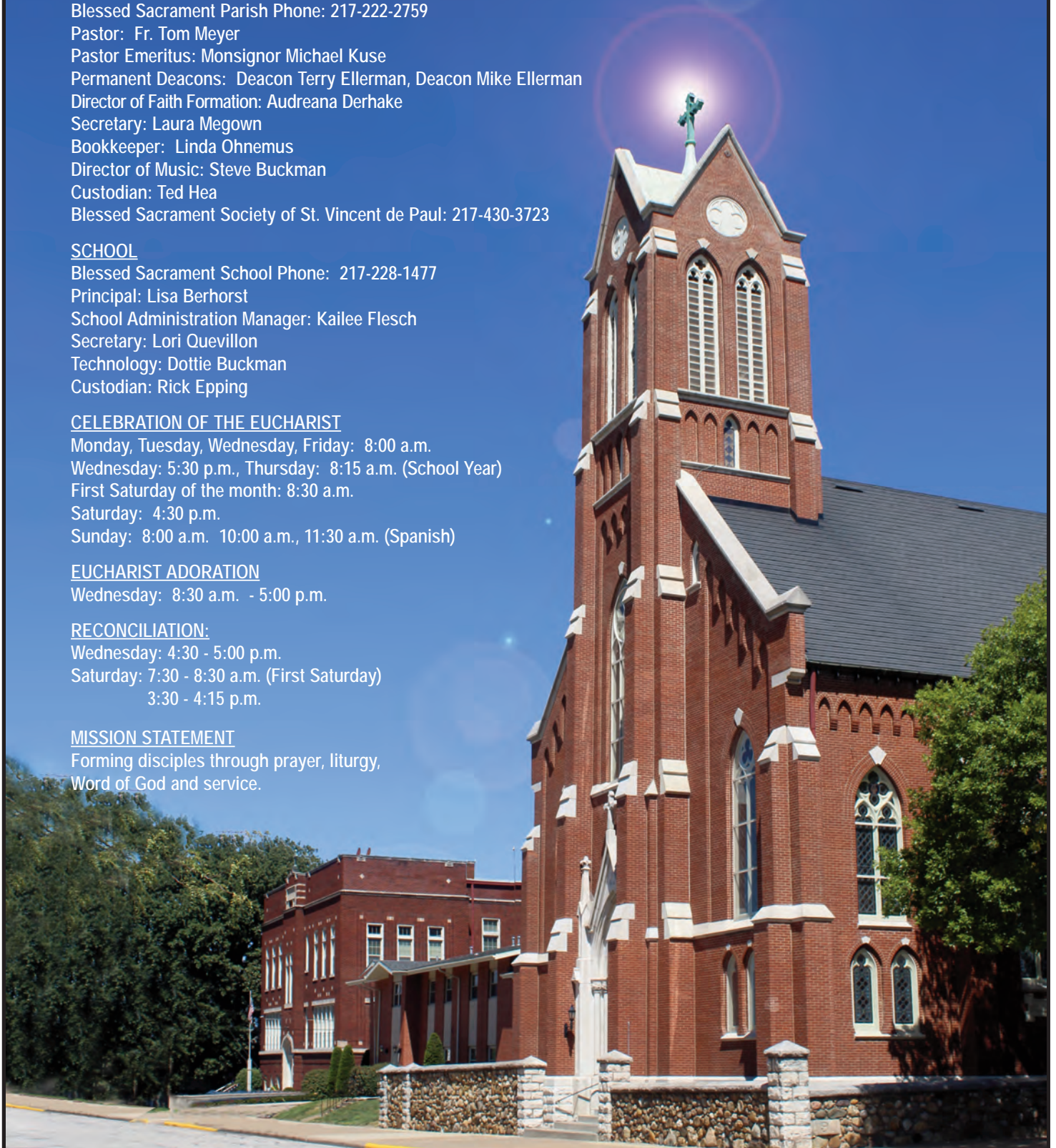

From the Pastor's Desk

Today, we celebrate the **2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time**. We hear the story today of Jesus' first miracle at the Wedding Feast of Cana. After the wine runs out at the reception Jesus turns jars of water into wine. At the surprise of the headwaiter, this is the "good wine" that is served second. There is something symbolic happening here. The first wine represents God's covenant with Israel. This ancient covenant is surpassed by the New Covenant (New Wine) which Christ makes with his bride the Church. The Wedding Feast of Cana thus anticipates our eternal heavenly marriage feast with Christ.

Next weekend (January 25/26) the Universal Church celebrates the "**Sunday of the Word of God.**" The Church celebrates the importance of the Sacred Scriptures in our everyday lives of faith. Blessed Sacrament Parish is celebrating this day by gifting our 8th Grade students with brand new Bibles of their own from the Great Adventure Catholic Bible series. I would like to express my gratitude to the many parish members who donated for each of our 8th Grade students to receive this Bible. Thank you all for helping give our students a beautiful keepsake for their journeys of faith.

Next weekend marks the beginning of **Catholic Schools Week (January 26-31)**. We will kick-off the week with Sunday Masses next Sunday, January 26. Many events will be planned throughout the week. I invite you to share in our excitement of celebrating Catholic education here at Blessed Sacrament in Quincy.
