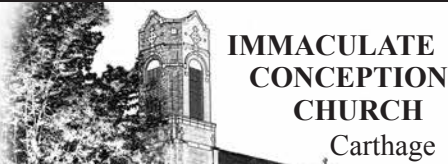


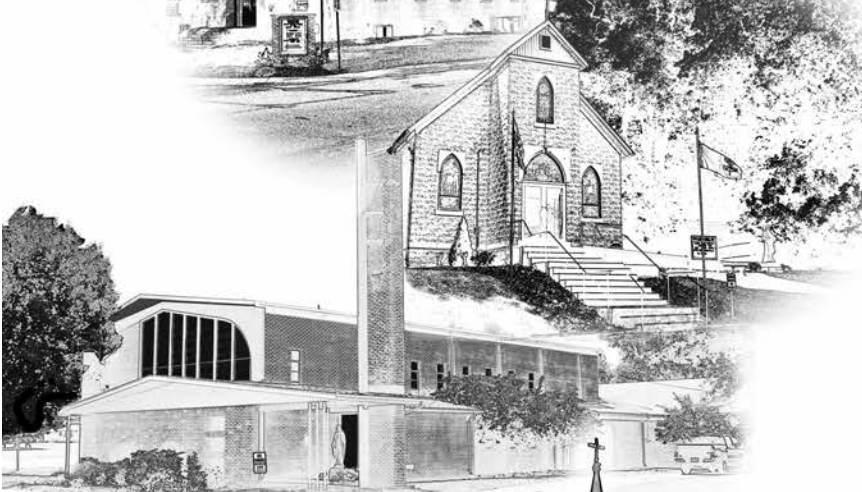

## **Jubilee Year: Pilgrims of Hope - Indulgences, Conclusion.**

We have just passed Valentine's Day, and if all you got out of it was luxurious pajamas, chocolates, cards, messages, music, and the like, you missed the most important thing about it. Somebody intentionally decided to cling to his faith when threatened with the loss of his life if he didn't deny his faith - and made of his martyrdom an offering in union with the suffering and death of Jesus Christ on the Cross. Yep: did it for love! Go ahead: wish that kind of intentional life for someone you ardently love. See how that goes.

It's that word, "intentional," with which we leave you, as we come to the conclusion of our treatment of Indulgences. The abuses of the past - centuries past - do not in any way minimize the power of Indulgences as well as the opportunity they provide for us. Why are Indulgences so powerful, properly understood and properly practiced?

Because Indulgences provide us a way to enter into and participate in the purification of souls, in Purgatory, in the Mystical Body of Christ. *And in consciously, deliberately placing ourselves within an intention to be a part of the grace of purification, we give ourselves a reason to advance our own spiritual life.* Look: suppose you're struggling with an addiction of some kind...let's say, pornography. That's a tough one: most addictions are, because you have to tirelessly fight against them at precisely the time you're about to give up on trying to fight anymore. But try this. **(continued on next page)**

**(continued)** Enter into an Indulgence for yourself, and for a family member whom you still grieve, who has died. OK: there's your reason to be free of sin, and to say "No" to the slightest attraction to sin. See, that's a motivation. Then come the prayers in union with the Holy Father, Pope Francis: you're holding yourself to what you're supposed to believe about the truth of the teaching of the Church, and you want that - for the sake of the soul for whom you're offering the Indulgence. That's focus. Confession and Communion at Mass won't be mindless this time around: you have a reason to be sincere and attentive. That's unleashing the power of a sacrament. And the prayer, or work of mercy, act of charity, or practice of virtue you offer: when the enthusiasm and attentive begin to fail, you're still committed to stay on track for someone to whom you've committed and united yourself. That's commitment.

Need help with an intentional life? Tired of spiritually doing nothing more than just existing - if you even want to call it that? Want to actually experience how the Mystical Body of Christ really operates? It's all here for you: Indulgences. Properly understood and practiced.
