

Rabbi Jonathan Sacks recently shared a gem of wisdom from a Jewish sage:

There is a wonderful story about an 18th century rabbi, Levi Yitzchak of Berdichev, who is looking at people rushing to and fro in the town square. And he wonders why they're all running so frenetically.

He stops one and he says, "Why are you running?" And the man says, "I'm running to make a living. " And the rabbi says to him, "How come you're so sure that the living is in front of you and you have to run to catch it up?

What is it that you are looking for?

Are you clear on that? If you are not clear, you may someday wake up and realized you have missed something deeper. Or, much worse, you

may not wake up and never realize till the end that you have gone down the wrong road—and that you are out of gas.

As fast as most of us are moving down life's road we may inadvertently pass it by. As John Lennon observed: "Life is what happens to you while you are making other plans."

Toward the end of his life someone asked General Robert E. Lee, the Great Confederate Commander, if he had had any regrets. He replied softly, "That I took a military education." That must be must be one of the more sad personal self- assessments that has ever been spoken.
