

Are you utilizing Formed?

The Hancock County Catholic Churches subscribes to FORMED for all of our parishioners. This is an awesome platform with Catholic visual and digital media. You can download it as an app on your phone or on your smart TV, just like you would Netflix or YouTube TV. To create an account, go to www.formed.org/signup Enter "Hancock County Catholic Churches", Follow the directions, enter your name and email, then you have an account! Every time you log in, there is no password- you enter your email and it sends you a link to log in. Once you log in once to your app on your smart tv, it will keep you logged in. This lent, challenge yourself to watch something beneficial for your soul on FORMED.

The Catholic Church's Observance of the Season of Lent.

Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. Priests, religious, and laity are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of charity and mercy.

- 1. Everyone of 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, March 5, and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday, March 5, and Good Friday, April 18, 2025.
- 3. On these two days of fast and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- 4. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious matter


