

## **A Spiritual Communion**

My Jesus, I believe that You are in the Blessed Sacrament. I love you above all things, and I long for You in my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. As though You have already come, I embrace You and unite myself entirely to You; never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

#### Why Do You Seek the Living Among the Dead?

This year's Holy Week and Easter seasons take place in the midst of the realignment of our five churches to a single parish with three church sites. Two of our five church sites will be no longer in use, effective July 1 of this year. St. Mary Church in Hamilton, and Sacred Heart Church in Dallas City, bear the burden of this change; these closings are ours, whole and entire, no matter which the church site of our choosing. But Hamilton and Dallas City Churches experience our loss, as their loss, in a direct way. What is said about the passage of the body of Jesus, from Palm Sunday, to Holy Thursday & Good Friday, to Easter, is true for the body of Jesus Christ as a Passover of our churches and our parish. Our Lord's triumphal entry into Jerusalem involved an unfair, unjust sentence of suffering, death, and loss, transformed into a willing sacrifice that insured a tremendous victory. The washing of the feet of the apostles on Holy Thursday took place on a night of betrayal, and at Judas' feet, Jesus taught his apostles to place themselves in lowly service to those who would betray them.

Good Friday: Jesus willingly offered himself on the cross, precisely for us, whose sins put him there. And on Easter, there's Peter, trying to figure it out in the empty tomb: the Lord's body was in here...it's not here now...he'll see for himself that the Lord's body won't look like it used to look.

This is exactly the passage that our Hamilton and Dallas City churches are making, on behalf of all of our churches, all of us. Something placed upon their shoulders has to be transformed into a willing sacrifice; they are called to serve the very people and decisions betraying them; their last day, a death offered precisely for those deciding their fate; and the Body of Christ in Hancock County, our former appearance entombed, will have a new look yet to be revealed. There's a sacrifice to be offered, and for an outcome that might not be ours to see, at that.

The Paschal Mystery is being played out in our churches. Don't bypass how demanding the Easter message of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ can be. Fr. T.


