If you are new to Immaculate Conception or have been coming for a while, please register with our parish! #### Change in reception of Holy Communion

As mentioned at Mass last weekend, I would like for us to change the way in which we receive Holy Communion in the hand. In the distant past, I think there may have been an instruction that once you receive the sacred host (the actual Body of our Lord) in your hand you are asked to step aside to consume our Lord so that the next communicant may step up. I'm asking that from now on if you receive Holy Communion in your hand please do NOT step to the side but first reverently consume the sacred host before you step aside or turn to depart for your pew. I believe this can help us to be more intentional about what and who we are receiving and to foster even great reverence for the Eucharist. Parents, please help children know this revised way of receiving Holy Communion. Let us all endeavor to be more like the One whom we humbly and graciously receive in Holy Communion.
