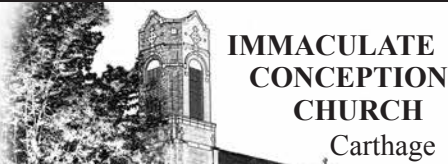


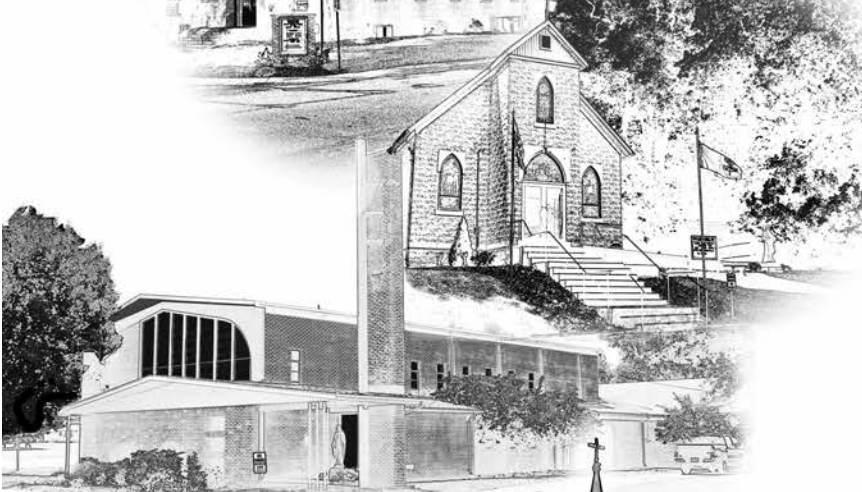

**Time for Focus: Part III.** In Chapter 6 of the Gospel of St. John, the chapter on the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist, Jesus asks the apostles the question: "And yet is not one of you the devil?" Our Lord was doing more than identifying Judas and his coming betrayal. How did the body of Jesus Christ wind up being crucified and then risen from the dead? The answer: through the betrayal of Judas! Of all things! Judas was there for the first Consecration of bread and wine into the Lord's Body and Blood, given up and poured out for us the next day; his feet were washed. The bridge between Holy Thursday and Good Friday? The betrayal of Judas. Look at what our Lord can do with an act of betrayal. Look at what he can do with a cross. *And Jesus Christ washed the feet of his betrayer; He offered His life for the people who wanted to kill Him!* As we come closer to the actual date of our beginning as Holy Archangels Parish, let's identify any lack of forgiveness in our lives - especially when it comes to the changes we are now undergoing - and transform any feeling of being betrayed by our circumstances, into a willing sacrifice, for the very people who have brought our situation upon us.
