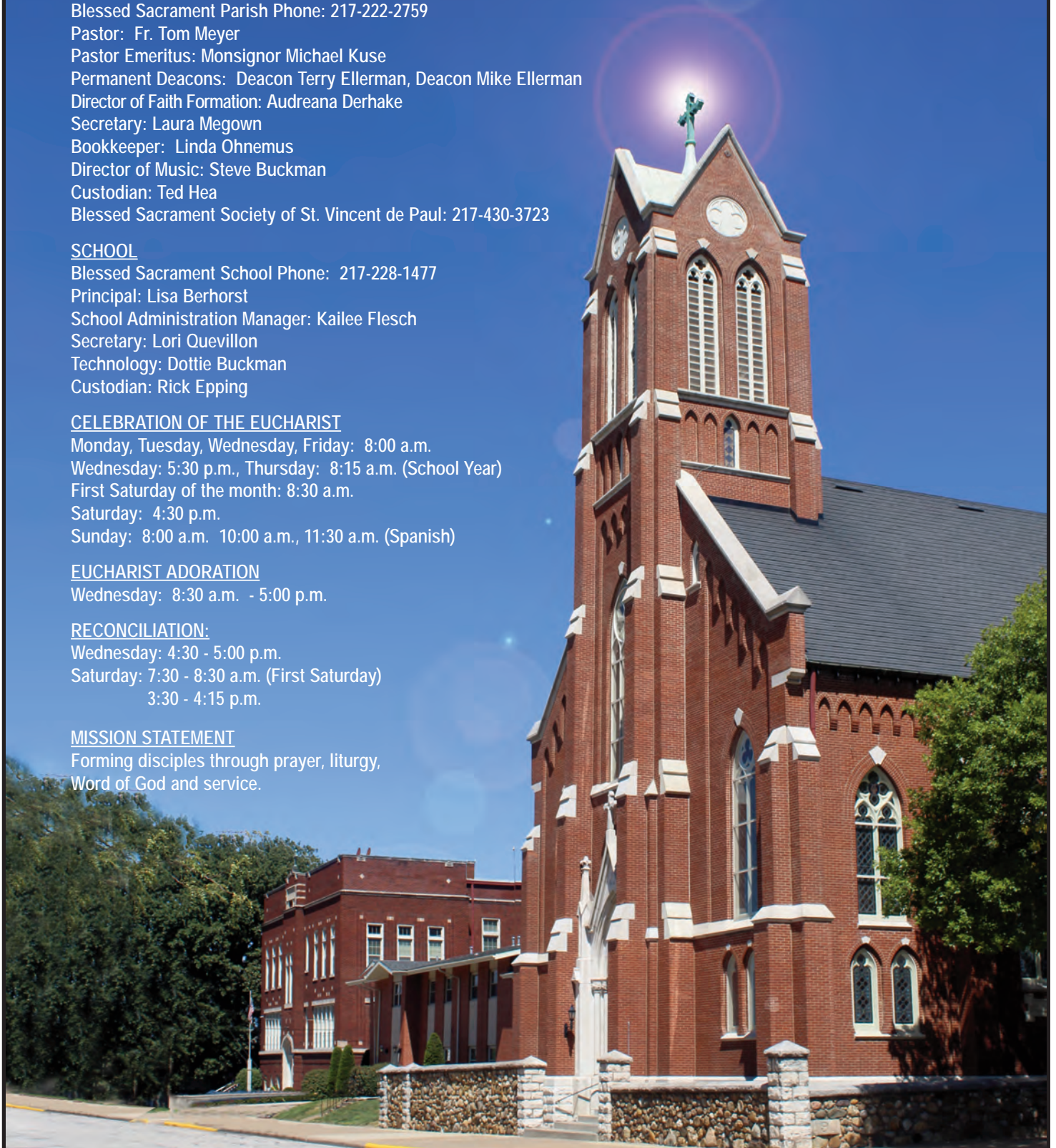

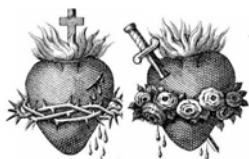
“...Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid.”
