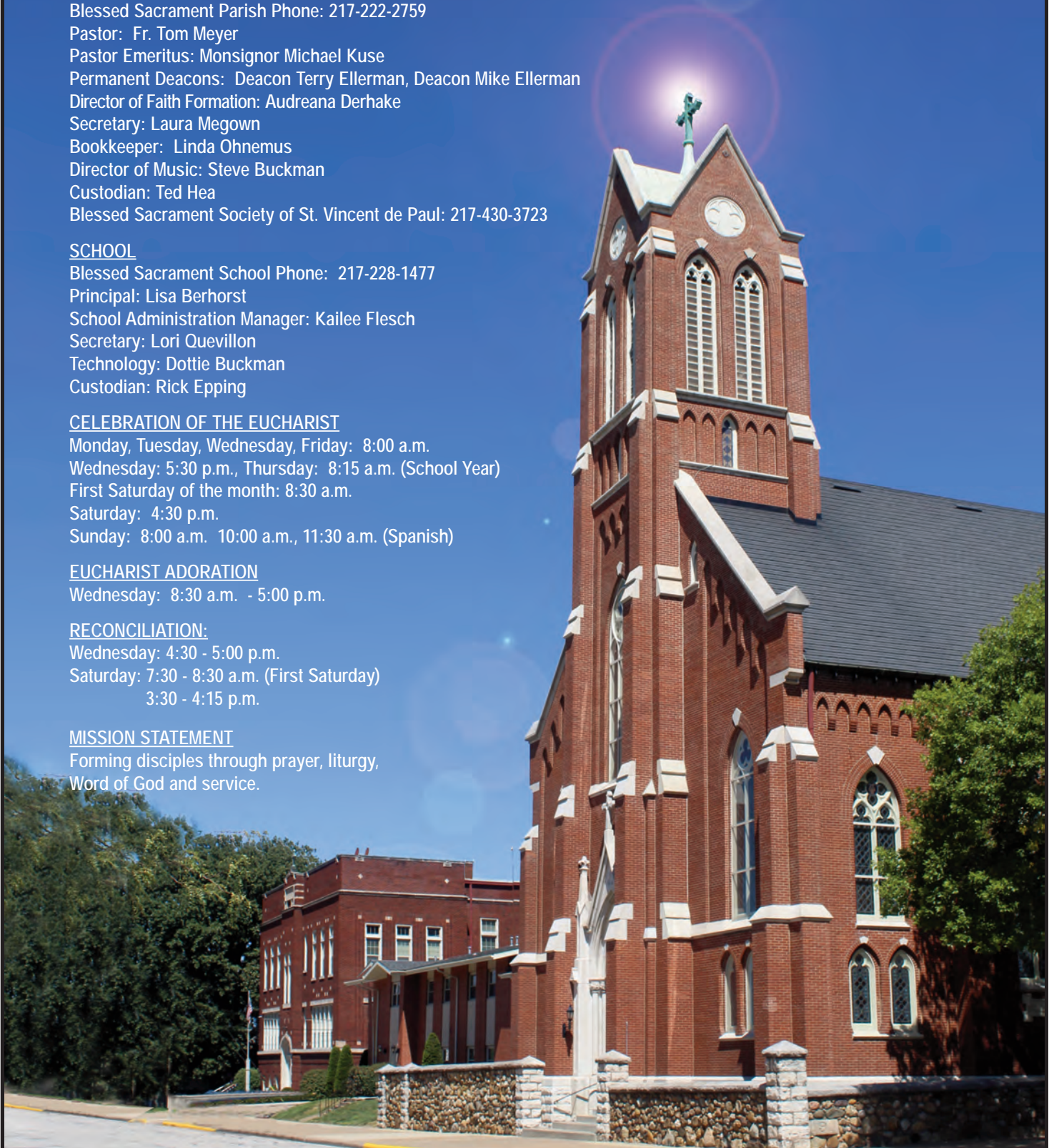

Today we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord**. We celebrate today Christ's ascension into heaven after forty days of post-Resurrection appearances to his disciples. At his ascension the gospel writers describe that Christ "took his seat at the right hand of God." According to St. Paul, God the Father "put all things beneath (Christ's) feet and gave him as head over all things to the church." Christ now rules as King and Shepherd until the end of time when he will bring "all in all".

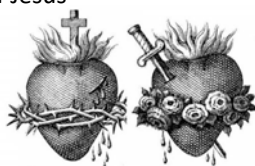

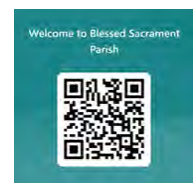
