

Nauvoo LDS Temple Visitor Center: News About Wells Street. The new Visitors Center for the Nauvoo LDS Temple is speeding toward completion: which means that there's going to be work on Wells Street. Agreement has been reached with LDS for them to repave the curbing on "our side of the street," from St. Joseph House to Young Street, while preserving the driveway, as well as the paving in front of our church. Work will also begin across the street, to expand Wells Street so that parking places to which we are accustomed will be preserved. Expansion of the street for parking will take place only on "the other side of the street." (Be nice!) Tentatively, work is expected to begin in the last half of the month of July. While this work is going on, our Nauvoo Masses will take place at the Alleman Knights of Columbus Hall in downtown Nauvoo. More details to come. 


