

Growing Disciples Update As We Head Toward the Month of July. The name of our newly aligned parish is "Holy Archangels Parish". The name of our church sites are: Sts. Peter and Paul Nauvoo Primary Site; Immaculate Conception Secondary Site; Sacred Heart Warsaw Secondary Site. *We do not lose the names of our individual church sites.* We can be addressed as...a few examples here: Holy Archangels Parish at Sts. Peter and Paul Church; Immaculate Conception Church of Holy Archangels Parish; Holy Archangels Catholic Church Rectory. *But we do not lose the names of our individual churches as we know them.* The reason for the name, "Holy Archangels Parish": too many St. Michael's around. So, Fr. Tony told the Bishop, "We have Sts. Peter and Paul with Joseph Smith and Brigham down the block; we have the history of plural wives across the street from the Immaculate Conception in Carthage; and we have the Sacred Heart where the Warsaw posse came from. We need a stand alongside the angel Moroni. So how about including the other two archangels, and letting us be Holy Archangels Parish?" And the Bishop agreed.
