Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Pentecost, fifty days after Easter, fifty days after having celebrated the Resurrection of the Lord. Pentecost celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and Mary, fulfilling the Lord's promise to send an Advocate, the Spirit of Truth, and to be with us always. The Solemnity draws to a close our Easter Season. On Monday, we return to Ordinary Time, entering in at the Tenth Week.

As we celebrate this great Solemnity of Pentecost, may our hearts be ever more open to the stirrings of the Holy Spirit and may we seek to perfect the virtues through the Gifts of the Holy Spirit first given to us in Baptism and sealed in Confirmation.

-INSTITUTION OF LECTOR – On Saturday, June 14, six men will be instituted as Lectors by Bishop Paprocki in Springfield. These six men are in Formation for the Permanent Diaconate. In the apparitions to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, Jesus gives these twelve promises for those who are devoted to His Sacred Heart: I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life; I will establish peace in their families; I will console them in all their troubles; They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death; I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings; Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy; Tepid souls shall become fervent; Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection; I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored; I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts; Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced; The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance. They shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments. My heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.
