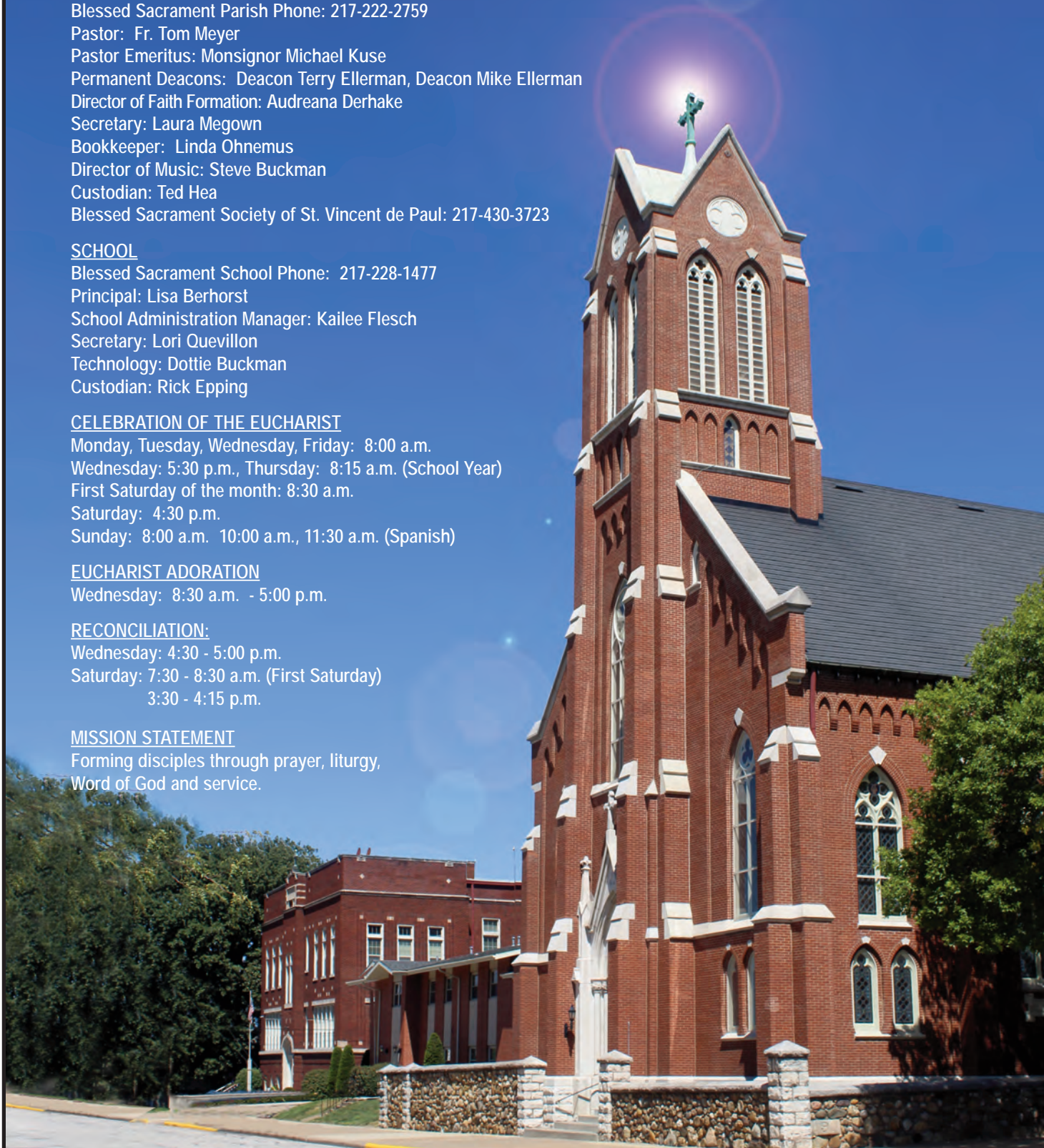

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Today we celebrate the 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the gospel story today we hear the story of two sisters, Martha and Mary. Martha is worried about the demands of preparing a meal. Her sister Mary is concerned about listening to her guest and making him (Jesus) feel welcomed. Both are complementary aspects of our Catholic faith: (1) making time for *service* and (2) making time for *prayer*. Our prayer life motivates us to serve others; and our service draws us into a deeper relationship with Christ. We re-commit ourselves to grow in these two areas of our Catholic life - prayer and service.

It is time to begin thinking about RCIA. In a few weeks we will return to weekly sessions of RCIA for those considering entrance into the Catholic faith. The first several months of RCIA are considered a period of "Inquiry" when participants have a chance to learn more about the Catholic faith without making any specific commitments. 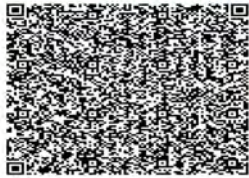
