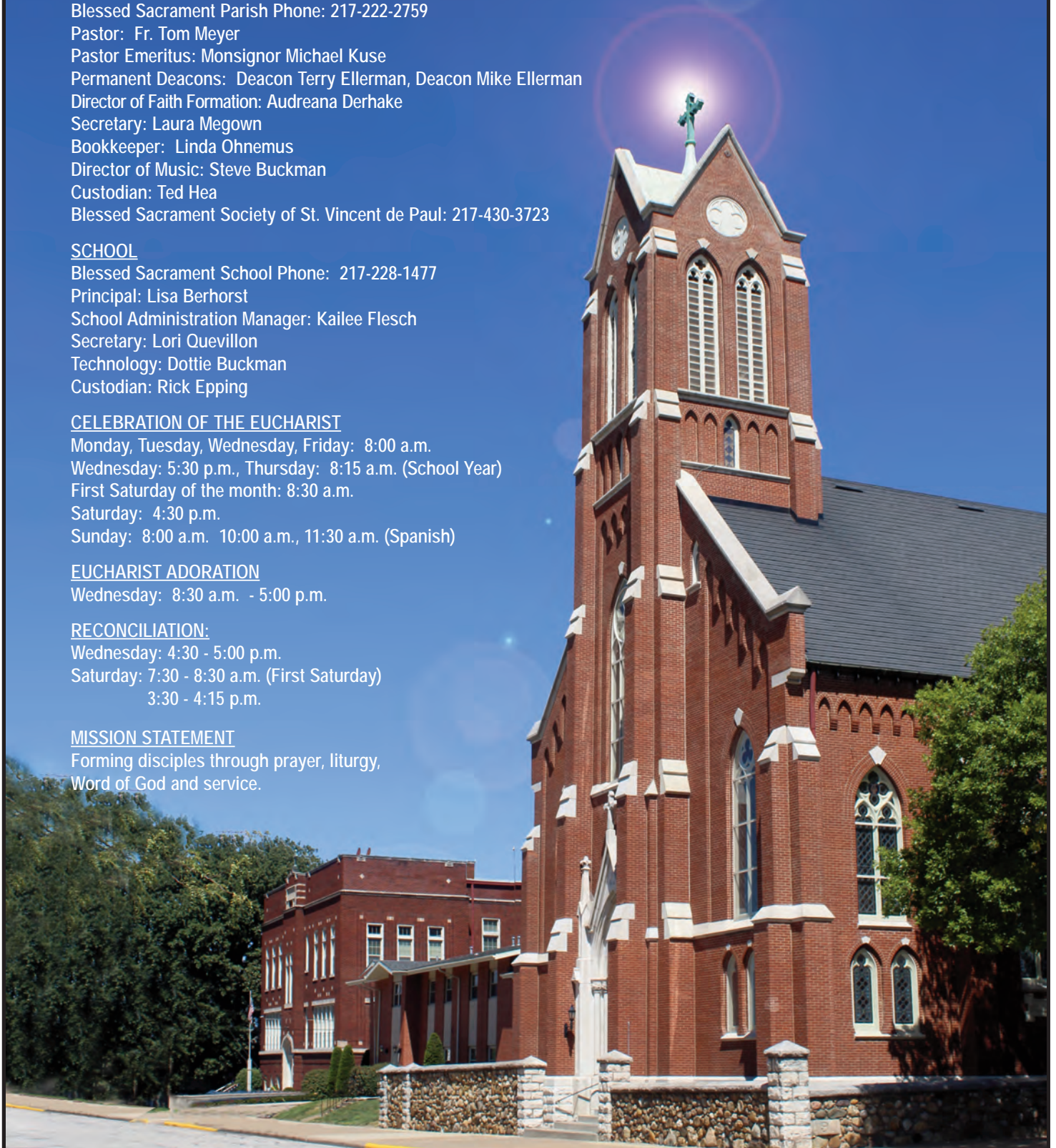

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the gospel story Jesus speaks to us about the importance of *perseverance in prayer*. "For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." Prayer isn't so much about changing God's mind. Prayer is more about aligning my own heart with the will of God. So persevering in prayer may not mean getting the things I want. Rather it may mean accepting the path that lies ahead, and trusting in the Lord who walks that path with me.

Finally, it is time to begin thinking about OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults). In a few weeks we will return to weekly sessions of OCIA for those considering entrance into the Catholic faith. The first several months of OCIA are considered a period of "Inquiry" when participants have a chance to learn more about the Catholic faith without making any specific commitments.
