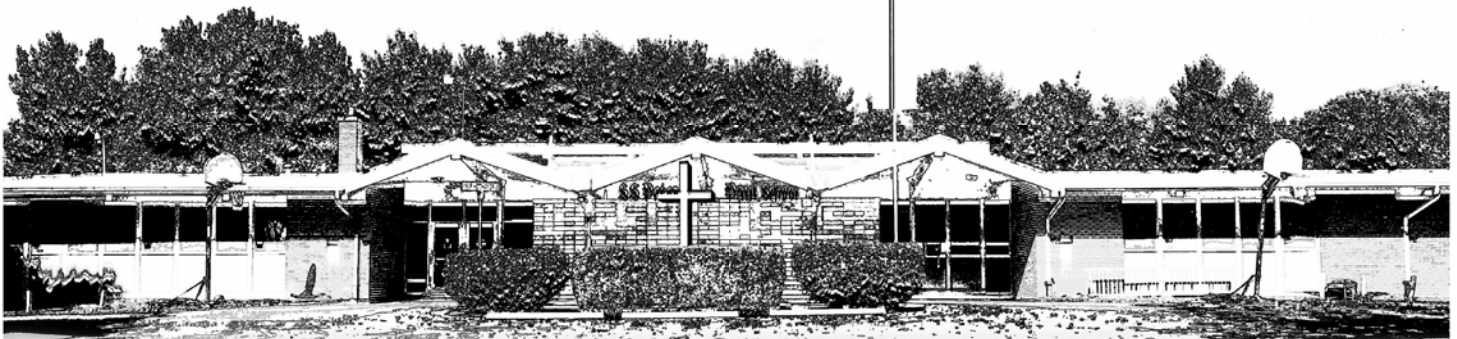

**The Solemnity of the Assumption, August 14/15.** Preserved from Original Sin, with the grace of being able to exercise her human freedom perfectly because that's what freedom from sin does, Mary, the mother of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, experiences her Assumption, body and soul, into heaven. The Assumption of our Mother in the order of grace is an expression of veneration, love, and joy. It's also an anticipation of our own presence in heaven, body and soul, when Our Lord comes again. ***Our annual outdoor Mass on the Eve of the Assumption takes place on Thursday, August 14, at 5:30 p.m., at our Immaculate Conception Church site (Carthage) of our Holy Archangels Parish. Masses on Friday, August 15, will be 5:30 p.m. at Sts. Peter and Paul Church site (Nauvoo), and Noon at Sacred Heart Church site (Warsaw).***

**Wells Street Repair and Expansion Coming Soon.** The first round of the major project on Wells Street involves the following dates: Tuesday, July 22, valve replacement at the corner of Wells and Young Streets; and beginning Tuesday, July 29, extension of a small part of our SPPS parking lot into the storm drain. The work on Wells Street running by the school is set for completion by August 8. The work on Wells Street running by the SPPN Church and St. Joseph House will begin after Labor Day weekend, and extend into the middle of October. *It's during this period of time that our Masses will be taking place at the Knights of Columbus Alleman Council Hall in downtown Nauvoo.* We'll keep you posted on any further updates!

**Perpetual Novena, Wednesdays, at ICC, 6:30 to 7:30 p.m.** Please join in solidarity and support for our Spanish-speaking brothers and sisters and fellow parishioners who are confronting the anxiety over visas and work permits already submitted and in process, but not processed in time due to the increase of work involved in the midst of this national issue. This will be a novena of Wednesdays, having begun last Wednesday, July 9. We are not dealing with the issues confronting the nation, however their presentation from several news sources. Our people have met the requirements of the law; they seek acceptance; they welcome our culture; they wish to share theirs in a complementary way. Whether for the entire hour, or a mere few minutes, please consider the strength and fellowship shown by coming for this special need for prayer.
