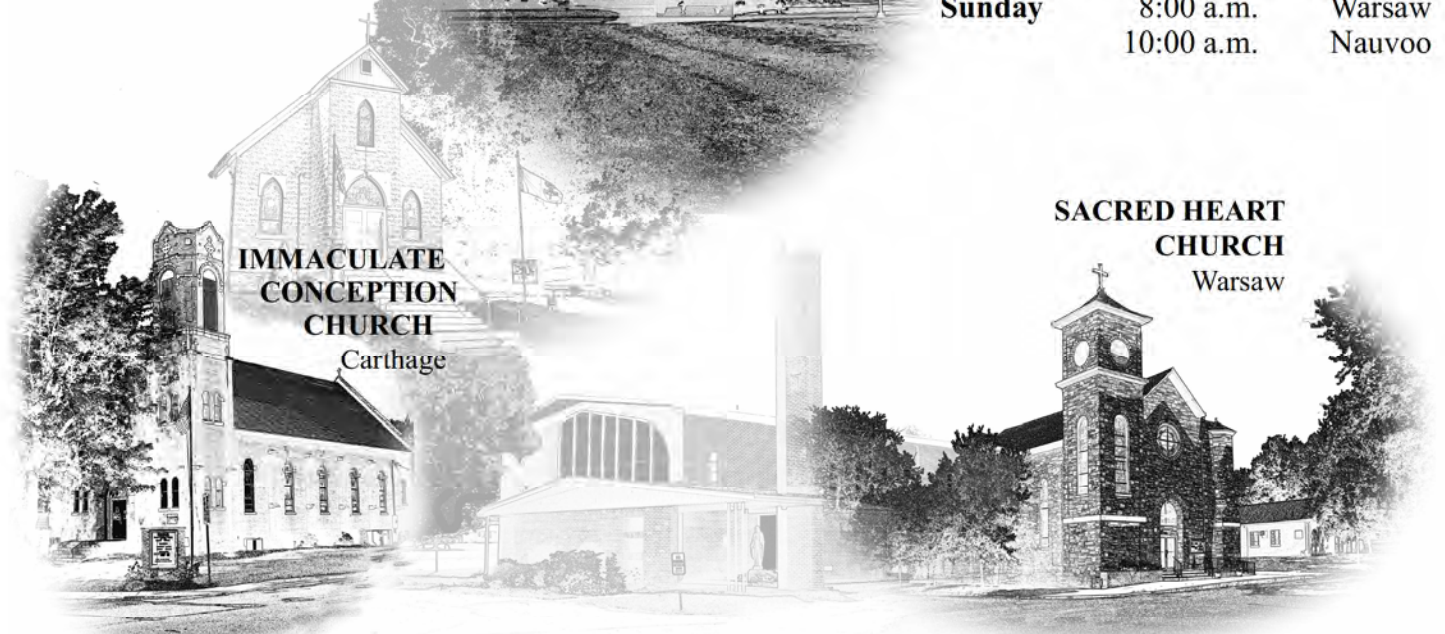

Masses at Alleman Council K of C Hall: The Time Has Arrived for SPPN Church Site. Work on Wells Street, preserving street parking and working on curb repair, will begin on Wednesday, September 17. *Therefore: Friday morning Mass on September 19 with SPPS present will take place at the school gym; and Sunday morning Mass on September 21 will take place at Alleman Council K of C's in downtown Nauvoo.* This arrangement is going to last for a few weeks. We have assurances that adjustments to accommodate funerals at SPPN can be arranged, should we have to schedule them. We ask from you what you have always given, in anticipation of this temporary change in location: your patience, and consideration of each other. The parking places by the back door of the K of C Hall should be reserved for people with difficulties in mobility. *Please make it a point to stay around awhile, after the September 21 Mass. Coffee and other drinks, donuts, and breakfast pizza will be offered for all who remain for some time together before we go our separate ways.* Let's see how all this goes!!

Annual Diocesan Appeal: "Proclaiming Christ, Yesterday, Today, and Forever." We urge everyone to carefully consider the position of the Diocese with regard to vocations to the priesthood - and therefore, our position recently affected by the need for vocations. Our generosity, sacrifice, and willingness to understand the situation is the remedy we need to advance vocations to the priesthood; any reticence in our offerings only advances the depth of the problem that brought about the way we were affected in the first place. Once again, here's the challenge set before us, the Holy Archangels Parish of the Church of Peoria:

Sts. Peter and Paul Nauvoo Church Site: \$27,317.

Immaculate Conception Carthage Church Site: \$26,725.

Sacred Heart Warsaw Church Site: \$17,536.

Sacred Heart Dallas City Church Site Designated "No Longer In Use": \$15,571.

St. Mary Hamilton Church Site Designated "No Longer In Use": \$16,988.

The Total for which Holy Archangels Parish is Responsible: \$104,137.

This goal takes into account the discount for which we qualified, because of our support for SPPS.

About the Methodology for Setting ADA Parish Goals. In the interest of openness and transparency, our Finance and Pastoral Councils will receive the methodology for setting ADA parish goals. And any parishioner who wishes to receive a copy of the methodology will receive one upon request, communicated to the rectory/to Fr. Tony. While we keep access to concrete financial information to our Councils, at least parishioners can have a grasp of how the Diocese determines what each parish in the diocese is assigned to give.

Want to Try Helping Our Latino People Learn English? Many Latino people do not come to our Masses because they are unfamiliar with the English language, and thus feel awkward being around English speaking people - and those of us who speak English face the same lack of familiarity and awkwardness. So, here's the offer! We have bilingual missalettes at our IC Church Site of Holy Archangels Parish. We're looking for those English speaking parishioners who would be willing to "team up" with Latino individuals or families, sit next to them in Church during Mass, and guide them through the missalette. Turning to the appropriate pages...pointing out the Spanish text matching the English text...making connections on a level deeper than language...and seeing to it that you keep sitting together, week by week, as we get more comfortable with each other. A translation app on your phone would be a tremendous additional help in establishing parishioner friendship. Want to give it a try? Contact Fr. Tony. Let's see what we can do!
